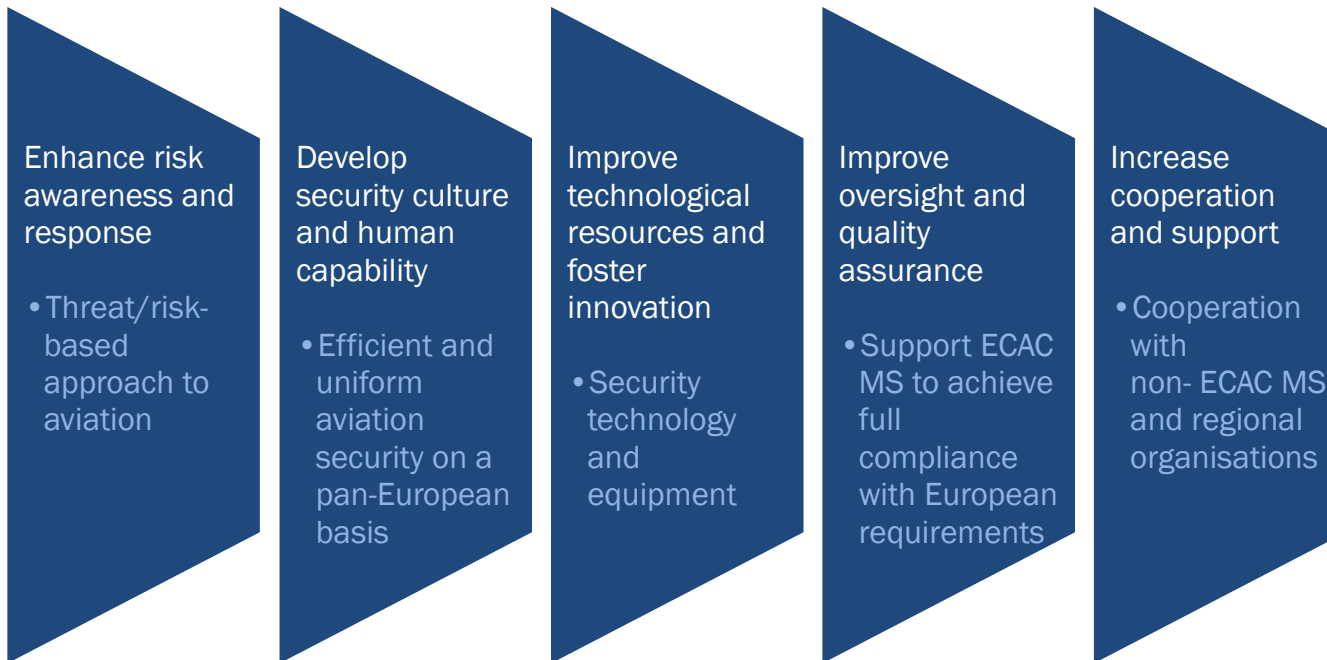


ECAC Work Programme 2016-2018

- To promote a threat/risk-based approach to aviation security
- To promote the development and use of security technology and equipment to address current and emerging threats
- Based on ECAC Doc 30, Part II, to pursue the development of efficient, effective and uniform aviation security measures on a pan-European basis
- To support Member States in achieving full compliance with European requirements, and further developing their security regimes
- To promote cooperation with non-ECAC Member States and regional/sub-regional organisations

1. Enhance Risk Awareness and Response

- Regular debates at ECAC Security Forum meetings
- Recommendations and guidance material (Doc 30 Part II and Annexes, ECAC Aviation Security Handbook)
- Capacity-building activities on risk management
- Performance of ECAC vulnerability assessments

2. Develop Security Culture and Human Capability

- Guidelines and workshops on security culture
- Model security training programmes
- Training courses and capacity-building activities
- Training and certification requirements for security personnel
- Guidance on staff motivation

3. Improve technological resources and foster innovation

- ECAC Common Evaluation Process of security equipment (CEP)
- Technical specifications for security equipment
- Guidelines on routine testing
- Capacity-building activities on equipment and technology

4. Improve oversight and quality assurance

- ECAC Audit Programme
- Training and capacity-building activities for national auditors
- Model national programmes (training, quality control, contingency, screener certification)
- Guidelines on quality control system



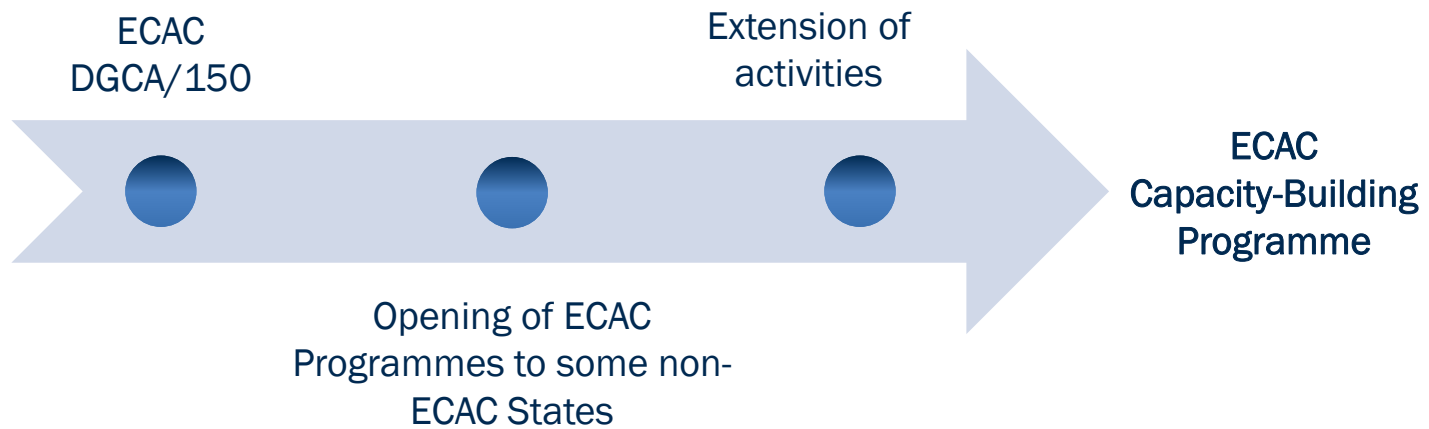
