USAP-CMA: 8.17 & 8.19

8.17 Each Contracting State shall establish a national air transport facilitation programme . . .

 \rightarrow [Annex 17 (3.1.1) Establish & implement a written NCASP]

8.19 Each Contracting State shall establish a National Air Transport Facilitation Committee, and Airport Facilitation Committees as required, or similar coordinating bodies . . .

Background: Doc 10042

- Developed to provide guidance on Standards 8.17, 8.18 & 8.19
- EC 6/3 15/90, Completion of Compliance Checklist
 - \rightarrow Council request to draw States' attention to Doc 10042
- Not only means of compliance with Standards: Other appropriate methods
 - \rightarrow A39-20: "other appropriate means" for Annex 9 compliance
- NATFP to define roles of all entities involved in FAL activities





Definitions

Choice of State:

- \rightarrow define key terms used in NATFP document
- \rightarrow reproduce definitions found in Annex 9, Chapter 1



Objectives of the NATFP

- Clearly list/describe objectives of NATFP
- **Standard 8.18**: Each Contracting State shall ensure that the objective of its national air transport facilitation programme shall be to adopt all practicable measures to facilitate the movement of aircraft, crews, passengers, cargo, mail and stores, by removing unnecessary obstacles and delays.
 - \rightarrow primary, mandatory objective
- Coordination between government agencies
- Distribution & coordination of tasks
- NAFTF not responsible for implementation



LEGISLATION (As Appropriate)

- DGCA or other authority should initiate the process to obtain political mandate
- Lists of international conventions, regional agreements, national legislation, regulations, etc. that provide the basis for NATFP.
- Chicago Convention, Annex 9 + Annexes 15, 17, 18
- Instruments of the WCO, WHO + EU + UN (e.g.):
 - →UN Convention Against Transnational Organized Crime+Protocols (UNODC)
 - \rightarrow Conventions Relating to the Status of Refugees & Stateless Persons
 - \rightarrow Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities



ORGANIZATION & MANAGEMENT: NATFP

8.18.1 **Recommended Practice**.— In establishing a national air transport facilitation programme, States should use the guidance material outlined in Appendix 12 and Doc 10042...

Annex 9, Appendix 12: Model National FAL Programme

- Primary responsibility for Programme: CAA and/or the Ministry of Transport
- Participation of other agencies & airport and aircraft operators crucial
- Tasks *vis-à-vis* Articles of Chicago Convention

→National FAL Committee: NATFP implemented through NATFC's activities C

Chair: top CAA manager or other

Members: heads of Government agencies + CEOs of aircraft/airport
Mid-management to represent



• 8.19 Each Contracting State shall establish a National Air Transport Facilitation Committee . . . or similar . . . bodies, for the purpose of coordinating facilitation activities . . .

- Terms of Reference of NATFC
 - → Ensure coordination between relevant agencies & industry
 - \rightarrow Consider recommendations to enhance facilitation
 - → Discuss proposed changes to regulations: Annex 9 changes
 - \rightarrow Coordinate with NCASC
- Tasks and work programme (example)
- (Sample) Rules of Procedure: Attachment 1 of Doc 10042



Doc 10042: Airport FAL Committees

- 8.19 Each Contracting State shall establish . . . Airport Facilitation Committees <u>as</u> <u>required</u> . . . for the purpose of coordinating facilitation activities . . .
- Purpose: implement NATFP at the airport level
- Terms of Reference:
 - \rightarrow examine problems relating to clearance
 - \rightarrow provide solutions to problems
 - \rightarrow make recommendations to NATFC or relevant agency
- <u>Chair</u>: airport operator; <u>Members</u>: CAA, immigration, customs, airlines, security, ground-handling, quarantine/health
- Annex 9, Appendix 11: Model Airport FAL Programme
- <u>Scope</u>: SARPs of Annex 9 concerning border clearance processes (table)



ROLES, FUNCTIONS & RESPONSIBILITIES OF AGENCIES

- Allocation of responsibilities for implementation of FAL matters.
- Annex 9, Appendix 12: Examples of various agencies
- \rightarrow Functions may differ in each State (e.g. immigration \rightarrow border police; issuance of passports \rightarrow ministry of interior)
- Items for inclusion in NATFP:
- → Designated authority responsible for NATFP + Functions (e.g. review Annex 9 & file differences; provide secretariat support)
 - → Customs: Functions (Chicago Convention; Annex 9)
 - → Immigration: Functions (Chicago Convention; Annex 9)
 - \rightarrow Health: Functions (Chicago Convention: Annex 9)



DOC 10042; Other

- → Food and/or Agriculture (Annex 9)
- → Aircraft operators: Functions (Chicago Convention; Annex 9)
- → Airport operators: Functions (Annex 9)
- \rightarrow Aviation Security (Annexes 9 and 17)
- \rightarrow Ground Handlers
- → Travel Document Issuing Authority (Annex 9)
- \rightarrow Visa-issuing Authority (Annex 9)
- → Law Enforcement/Police (Annex 9)
- → Dangerous Goods (Customs? Other?); Disabilities (Annex 9)





EXAMPLES: NATFP IMPORTANCE

API STANDARD

• API Standard — Legal authority — Needs of all involved agencies

• Immigration; Customs; Border police; Law enforcement; Health; CAA; Department of Transport; Aviation Security; etc.

 \rightarrow Need for a coordinating body (NATFP)

• NATFP: a) legal authority; b) implementation



HEALTH EMERGENCIES

- Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS)
- "Swine flu"
- Ebola
- Plague (currently)

→ CAA + Health Agency + Aircraft operators + Airport operators
