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Aerodromes Certification Implementation



Priorities

- ❖Updating the aerodrome regulation as per last amendment of Annex 14 and PANS Aerodrome (GRF, master plan, PCN/PCR);
- Renewal and extension of the aerodrome certificates (domestic and international) by using mixed remote and onsite oversight;
- ❖ Use the exercise of the renewal of the aerodrome certificates to Implement of the CAP submitted to ICAO (CMA-USOAP audit 2020)

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Aerodromes Certification Implementation



- difficulty to conduct the surveillance activity (onsite) during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- No sufficient guidance from ICAO For aerodromes accepting only domestic movements.
- The idea is plan for separate process for those airports with more flexibility (landing area acceptance);

Runway safety teams Implementation



Priorities

- Runway Safety Team requirement was incorporated in the CAR aerodromes
- CAA has issued a guidance material Runway safety team handbook (based on ICAO handbook)
- Runway safety go-team conducted by ICAO MID in October 2018
- Implementation of RST at international Airports
- *RST were established in the 3 airports (OOMS, OOSA, OOSH).

Global reporting format Implementation



Priorities

- Establishment of National GRF implementation team
- Train accredited RWY assessors to get the best result of RWY observation
- Update SNOWTAM software (currently SNOWTAM transmission done using manual method)

Global reporting format Implementation



- Human Factors -still based on visual assessment of operations staff (accurate assessments, few guidance)
- Military ACFT doesn't follow civil regulation
- Training -CAA's/Aerodromes/Aircrew/ATC

ACDM Implementation



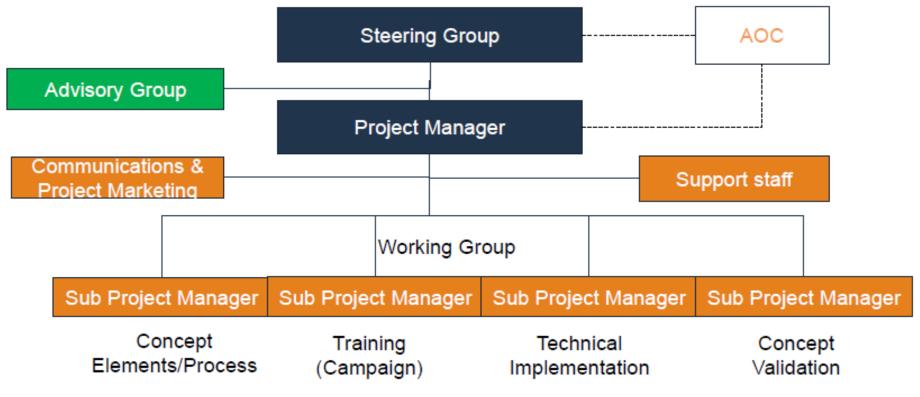
Priorities

- 2019 Oman Airports Awarded a contract to TO70 for "Consultancy Services for Support & Initiation of ACDM at Muscat International Airport"
- *Re-establish the Steering Group.
- *Re-establish the working groups.
- Socialize ACDM with the wider aviation sector.
- Complete procurement process and award contract to consultant for Phase 2 ACDM implementation.

- ❖ Joint aeronautical (AO and ACT) study to assess the risk of Airport Operations in Conjunction with Construction Work

- Consecutive update of Annex 14 (13, 14, 15,16(13-B)
- Future amendment of Annex 14 (significant change and improvement of OLS specification OLSS 2021)
