<u>Presented by</u>: Saudi Arabia (General Authority of Civil Aviation - AD Standards)

- ► To maintain the certification of all aerodromes open to public in Saudi Arabia:
- Continuity of safety oversight scheduled for aerodromes that are fully certified;
- Improve safety oversight and safety management capabilities post covid-19 including use of remote/virtual capabilities;
- ► Implement objectives and priorities of GASP associated with the aerodrome operations;
- Developed Safety Aviation State Program (SSP) taking into account GASP (In progress);
- Develop National Safety Plan covering aerodromes operations (In progress);
- Implementation of certification/authorization for heliports and helidecks.

Challenges

- Certification of all AD within the time frame;
- Normalization of Aerodrome Operations post Covid-19;
- Identification and resolve of high risk categories at operational safety at aerodromes;
- emerging risks due UAV operations near aerodromes and its potential impact on safety at aerodromes;
- Developing regulations for water aerodromes (in progress);
- Maintaining the safety oversight schedule;
- Conducting unscheduled inspections;
- Change management at aerodromes.

AERODROMES CERTIFICATION IMPLEMENTATION

- Runway safety team is mandatory under GACAR 139 and is part of AD/SMS manual;
- Improve the runway safety data collection methods;
- Identify risk factors, hot spots and national safety risks.

Challenges

- ► Full implementation of RST for all aerodromes;
- ► Safety data collection;
- ► Potential Hazards and their mitigations.

RUNWAY SAFETY TEAMS IMPLEMENTATION

- ► GRF implementation is mandatory under the GACAR 139 Version 7;
- The continuous flow of information and implementation of e-management systems;
- Enhance and enforce the concept of change management in aerodromes;
- Feedback and Follow up by all aerodrome entities;
- Conduct of awareness Sessions and on site trials;
- GACA and Airport Staff Training;
- Issuing of specific guidance as Advisory Circular (AC) on the implementation of GRF requirements developed under GACAR Part 139.

Challenges

- ► Implementation of GRF by 4th Nov 202;
- Implementation of GRF and awareness sessions;
- ► Reliable Delivery of information;
- Systems and mechanism development;
- On-line training and remote oversight implementation.

GLOBAL REPORTING FORMAT IMPLEMENTATION

- ► Fully implementation of ACDM using phased approach and starting with International Aerodromes;
- ► Include ACDM as one of the initiatives defined under Saudi National Air Navigation Plan (SNAP) expected to be available by Q2-2022;
- ► Data observation;
- ▶ Initiate the ACDM committee.

Challenges

- To finish the ACDM training and workshops;
- Management and culture change;
- New methods of implementation;
- Interfacing between all stakeholders to exchange the data of flights and their status and progress.

- Secondment of aerodrome Safety Inspectors to ICAO USAOP-CMA planned activities.

- ► Time Management;
- Maintain competent aviation professionals in the departments;
- Adoption of comprehensive training program leading to the certification of aerodrome Safety Inspectors.
