- medium term plan:
- Establishing a new passenger terminal at Damascus International Airport according to international standards/accommodating 25 million passengers annually/
- Installation of primary and secondary radar system covering all areas of the country and modern NAV AIDs
- ▶ Installation of meteorological, automatic and communications systems
- Installing an Airport Security Detection System and Camera Monitoring System
