# AERODROMES CERTIFICATION IMPLEMENTATION

- ► All UAE certified aerodromes currently have active LRSTs
- ► Consistent Implementation
- ▶ Stakeholder Engagement
- Observation by Regulator

## RUNWAY SAFETY TEAMS IMPLEMENTATION

## Challenges

- ▶ Use of Risk Management framework
  - Runway Incursion
  - Runway Excursion
- ► Outcomes for Safety Review Boards
  - Executive / Management Focus
  - Alignment to broader Safety Management framework

- ► Conduct table top exercises to allow Airport, ATC & AIS to experience and deal with real time situation
- ▶ On going practical trial runs
- ► Fine tuning ahead of full implementation

## Challenges

- ► Time in collaboration with ANSP for SNOWTAM system delivery
- Training to capture large shift teams
- Meeting initial target dates due to some staff stranded overseas due to pandemic
- Practical trials done with limited water and assumptions.

# GLOBAL REPORTING FORMAT IMPLEMENTATION

- Formalize partnerships within the ATM Community
- Agree on decision-making approach and principles
- Develop a Concept of Operations
- ▶ Define processes and procedures

## Challenges

- Stakeholder agreement on implementation of Generic Processes
- ▶ Technical infrastructure
- ► Human-Machine Interface

## Challenges

- ▶ Volume of simultaneous changes
- ► Starts Stops Starts
- ▶ Turnover of Staff at Aerodromes
- Contractor's Airside / Aerodrome Experience
- ► Changes of Scope
- Operational Challenges

# CURRENT/FUTURE AERODROMES EXPANSIONS/PROJECTS

- Re-establishment of market post-COVID
- Reopening of OMDW terminal
- ► To ensure that all staff have the appropriate and demonstrable competence
- Continual improvement in the area of training and competency
- Ownership of training and competency responsibilities

## Challenges

- Narrowing window for major works during time of low traffic
- Delivery of practical training during the pandemic
- Providing appropriate funding and resources for necessary training
- Selection of appropriate training provider
- Demonstration and tracking of competence
- Decentralized and inconsistent organisational management of training and competency across departments and facilities
- Unlike pilots and ATC, there is no prescribed standard to reach or frequency required in each area of airport operational training or competency checks
