





### Global Economic Recovery to 2019 Levels between 2021 - 2022



## Positive but Different Recovery Speeds Expected Across some Arab Countries




## Travel Demand Remains Weak During H1-2021



## Herd Immunity will be Extended until 2022... Maybe more?


Share of People who are Fully Vaccinated from COVID-19 from Total Population in Some Countries (Until 5, September)

Visiting these countries is possible, but you may have to quarantine on arrival or return. You might also need to show proof of vaccination or a negative test.






## Un-flown Seats on Average Reach 5% of Total Actually Planned Seats




## More Aircraft are in Service in 2021 compared to 2020 but Still Below Pre-crisis levels






### Aircraft Values are Still Under Pressure






