SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

AIR TRANSPORT DATA AND ANALYSIS WEBINAR

(28 – 29 SEPTEMBER 2021, 12:00 – 14:30 UTC)

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Air Transport Data and Analysis Webinar was successfully held from 28 to 29 September 2021, 12:00 14:30 UTC using MS Teams facility. The Webinar was organized jointly by ICAO, AACO and ACAO.
- 1.2 The Webinar was attended by a total of seventy (70) participants from ten (10) States (Bahrain, Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, UAE, USA and Yemen) and eleven (11) Organizations/Industries (AACO, ACAO, ACI, BOEING, CAPA, CIRIUM, IATA, IFATCA, ISHKA GLOBAL, different Airlines & ICAO). - 1.3 The main objective of the Webinar was to bring together all concerned stakeholders (States, Airlines, International Organizations and Industry) to assess the current trends and future expectations for the industry, globally and in the MID Region. Furthermore, the Webinar focused on the latest applications in data analytics to showcase the importance of data-driven decision-making in times of crisis.

2. OPENING REMARKS

- The main outcomes/key takeaways of the Webinar are as follows:
 - The webinar highlighted the importance of collaboration between all industry stakeholders in terms of data collection, processing and data sharing
 - The webinar identified new focus areas that needs to be monitored post-pandemic
 - All stakeholders should collaborate in producing reliable information to support operations and industry recovery
 - ICAO alongside AACO, ACAO and IATA to agree on a regional mechanism to work on data analysis, reporting, and regional groupings to minimize differences in data produced by organizations in the region
 - The webinar also identified environment as a key area that needs attention from a data perspective
 - AACO suggested to start working on data related to emissions with all concerned stakeholders and keep States and airlines up-to-date with the latest trends.
