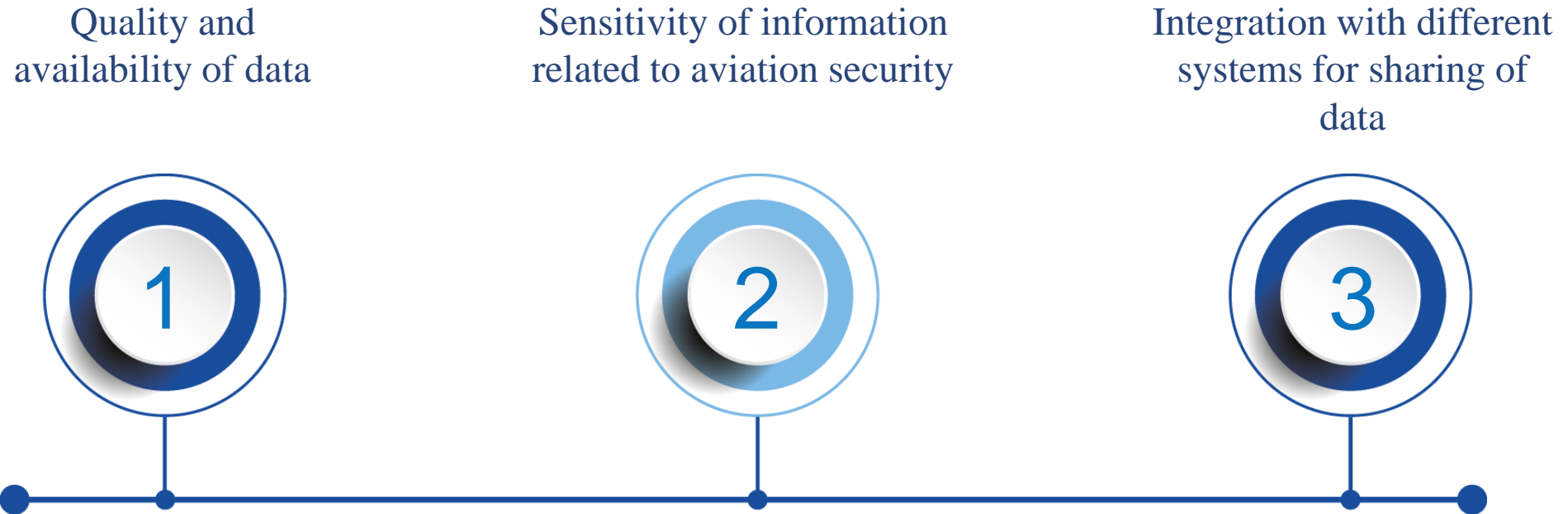

The Secure Supply Chain Regime Management

- Entities can apply in the platform to be a part of the secure supply chain in the state. (Regulated agent or known consignor).
- These entities will be approved by the appropriate authority.
- The platform will assign an auditor for site validation.
- Following a successful validation of the site, license will be issued with a unique identifier number.
- List of the regulated agents and known consignors and their unique identifier will be in the platform for all stakeholders.



Air Cargo e-Services:



Air Cargo Security Management

- Enabling the appropriate authority and other entities in the supply chain to track air cargo shipments electronically, so that air cargo are tracked from the first point to the moment they are being loaded into the aircraft.



Air Cargo e-Services:



Screening and Statuses

- Enabling screeners in the regulated agents and ground handlers at the airport to know the details of the shipments before arriving at the inspection point in the platform.
- Applying the screening method based on the nature of the shipment.
- Issuing a security status in an electronic format that transfer to interested parties.

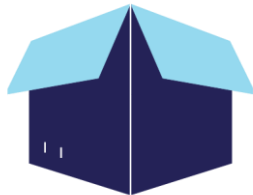

Advance Cargo Information

The 7 + 1 data elements

- Consignor, name
- Consignor, address
- Consignee, name
- Consignee, address
- Number of packages
- Total weight
- Cargo description
- HAWB and/or MAWB



Messages result from ACI analysis process

AC: Accept

RFI: Request For Information

RFS: Request For Screening

DNL: Do Not Load

- It is an additional layer of a multi-layered to the current air cargo security regimes.
- Identifying new threats in air cargo security supply chain and supporting existing security measures.

Risk assessment tool

- Looking at shipment information and knowing the risk of the shipment to choose the appropriate security method.
- Selecting shipments for random inspection. (Additional measures).
- Transfer and transit air cargo risk assessment.
- Great tool to states that screen all air cargo at the last moment before departure.
- Using machine learning to have a good understanding of a shipment's risk level.
