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AMENDMENT 29 TO ANNEX 9 - FACILITATION

Contains new and revised Standards and Recommended Practices related to public health emergencies, security of travel and health proofs, relief and repatriation flights, air transport facilitation of persons with disabilities, assistance to aircraft accident victims and their families, trafficking in persons



Amendment 29 became effective 18 July 2022 and will become applicable on 18 November 2022








ICAO TRIP Strategy:

Building Trust in Travel Document Security





Key Concepts - ICAO TRIP Strategy

Globally interoperable applications that provide for timely, secure and reliable linkage of MRTDs and their holders to relevant data in the course of inspection operations, e.g. API, PNR, SLTD

For the efficient and secure reading and verification of MRTDs, e.g. ABC, PKD



Objective: All Member States can uniquely identify individuals

Credible evidence of identity, involving the tracing, linkage and verification of identity

Manufacture of standardized MRTDs, that comply with ICAO specifications (Doc 9303)

Processes for document issuance by appropriate authorities, and controls to prevent theft and loss



Requirements for health proof certificates

Integrity

Authenticity

Trustworthy/Verifiable

Convenient to use

Data protection

Interoperability

Could the data have been altered after issuance?



Can issuance by a trusted authority be confirmed?



Are my systems capable of verifying integrity and authenticity?



Will the certificate be efficiently read within existing processes and infrastructure?



Compliant with legislation in State of use and State of nationality of the traveler




Will cross-border verification be possible?





ICAO Visible Digital Seal for Non-Constrained Environments (VDS-NC)



- Encodes minimum dataset for tests, vaccinations and recovery certificates
- Machine readable using standard barcode scanners (e.g. at check-in, bag drop, boarding gates)
- Digitally signed (optional for testing certificates),
 using the same infrastructure as used by more than
 145 States issuing ePassports

The ePassport


Recipients must verify the digital signature on the ePassport chip to ensure:

Authenticity


Issuance by genuine authority

Integrity

 Data hasn't been changed since issuance (including the facial image)



Without the PKD




With the PKD











ICAO Public Key Directory (PKD): Regulatory updates

 Assembly A41 Resolution – consolidated statement on facilitation:

"The Assembly...urges all Member States to join the ICAO PKD, upload relevant information from their own State to the PKD, and to use the information available from all States in the ICAO PKD to authenticate eMRTDs at border control"

Annex 9 Standard 3.9.2 (Amendment 28):

"Contracting States that participate in the ICAO PKD shall upload the public key data necessary for authentication of all electronic passports that they issue to the PKD."





An increasingly compelling case to participate

More need for PKD capabilities



More electronic documents – ePassport, DTC, VDS etc.



More demand for seamless/contactless travel



More need for agility in capabilities (robustness to pandemics etc.)

More value being provided at lower cost



Reduced fees



More data content, e.g. the ICAO Master List



Enhanced services and community sharing, e.g. the PKD Data Quality Coach initiative





New Services

Enhanced content

- New "Master List" (2020) easier to share key ePassport certificates.
- New "Health Master List" (2021) to support verification of vaccination and test credentials.

Improved capacity building

- Data Quality coach initiative: Participating States are mentored by an experienced coach from the PKD
- Costs (travel etc.) borne by the PKD
