1. LOCATION

1.1 ICAO MID Office, in partnership with the UAE General Civil Aviation Authority (GCAA) and the MID Flight Procedure Programme (MID FPP) will organize a Workshop on CCO/CDO implementation from **13 to 14 June 2022 in Abu Dhabi**, UAE. The Workshop will be hosted at the GCAA premises, the exact location will be decided upon the expected number of participants and will be announced in due course.

1.2 The Second Meeting of the ICAO MID Region Flight Procedure Programme Steering Committee (MID FPP SC/2) will be held back-to back at GCAA premises in <u>Sheikh Zayed Air</u> Navigation Centre, Abu Dhabi, UAE, from 15 to 16 June 2022.

6. TRANSPORTATION

6.1 Participants are requested to make their own arrangements for transportation from/to the airport and from/to the events venue.

6.2 Abu Dhabi Airport taxis are available 24 hours a day and the taxi ranks can be found directly outside each of the terminal building arrival areas. The drivers all have a good knowledge of the tourist attractions, hotels and other major locations in Abu Dhabi. All Abu Dhabi airport taxi drivers also command more than one language. The taxis at Abu Dhabi Airport are all metered cabs and are calculated according to the distance recorded.

7. INSURANCE

7.1 Participants are advised to have insurance coverage for any unexpected contingency including transport hazards (taxi, buses, rented cars, etc.) and Medical Coverage.

8. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

8.1 Vaccinated travelers to the UAE are not required to present a negative result of RT-PCR test for COVID-19 at the airport of departure. However, those who are not vaccinated must either present a valid, negative result of an RT-PCR test conducted within 48 hours before arrival or a recovery certificate (containing a QR code) from COVID-19 issued within 30 days before departure, if they were infected with the virus.

9. SOME USEFUL TRAVEL INFORMATION

PASSPORT/VISA

9.1 All foreign nationals entering the United Arab Emirates must possess a passport which is valid for a minimum of 6 months from the date of entry into the United Arab Emirates.

9.2 Visas when needed should be obtained from the original country. The GCAA events' Focal Point identified in paragraph 13 may assist in arranging invitation letters if needed. Participants should obtain updated information on entry requirements by accessing the UAE Government web page https://government.ae/en/information-and-services/visa-and-emirates-id.

Common documents requirement for visa application: Clear passport copy, white background clear photo, letter from employer/sponsor company in Arabic, home country ID for Pakistan, Iraq, Iran and Afghanistan. Please send all documents in JPEG format.

CUSTOMS

9.3 Each traveler is permitted to bring the following with them into the United Arab Emirates (UAE):

- 4 liters of alcohol or one (1) carton / 24 cans of beer
- AED 2,000 worth of cigarettes or 400 sticks of cigarettes
- AED 3,000 worth of cigars
- 2 kilograms of tobacco
- AED 3,000 worth of gifts, including perfume

10. CURRENCY, CREDIT CARDS AND BANKING SERVICES

10.1 The unit of currency in UAE is Dirhams (AED) with notes of 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500 and 1000 and coins of Fils 10, 25, 50 and 1 Dirham. The current rates of exchange for the major currencies are as follows:

USD 1= 3.673 AED EUR 1= 3.895 AED GBP 1= 4.617 AED More rates are available from <u>www.xe.com</u> 10.2 All passengers travelling through Abu Dhabi Airport carrying AED100, 000 or more or a sum of foreign currency of the same value are required to inform the customs personnel about the cash they have and they should also inform them about the precious items, such as gold and jewelry, they may have through their exit from the designated gates of such cases.

10.3 International Credit Cards, such as American Express, Visa, Master Card, etc., are usually accepted at most hotels, department stores and restaurants.

10.4 Foreign currency exchanges and ATMs are readily accessible at the airport and major shopping destinations.

10.5 Commercial banks, currency exchanges and major foreign currencies and branch networks stay open from 08:00 am to 04:00 pm for customers, six days a week, from Monday to Saturday, with Sunday being the day of closure, with a few exceptions. On Fridays, the aforementioned financial institutions stay open from 08:00 am and close at 12:00 pm to observe the Friday prayer.

12. WEATHER CONDITIONS
