### **High-level Conference on COVID-19 (Oct 2021)**

#### **Outcomes:**

- Declaration adopted that demonstrates the solidarity and determination in confronting COVID-19 challenges, and conveys a strong political "message" to international communities and world economies
- Recommendations accepted by the ICAO Council and 41<sup>st</sup> Assembly

Science-driven evidence-based decisions	Analysis of implemented measures by stakeholders





### High-level outcomes (March 2022)

Collaboration	Actions/ Considerations
Identify <b>stakeholders</b>	Establish relationships
Leverage existing <b>response</b> frameworks	International, regional, national
Identify essential operations and priorities	Emergency response, cargo, humanitarian, repatriation, others
Use/ adapt international mechanisms & tools	WHO, ICAO, IATA, ACI, IFALPA
<b>Standardization</b> of measures – difficult to obtain international consensus	Incremental = bilateral, multilateral, regional





### **CAPSCA Programme (March 2022)**

Recommendations	Actions/ Considerations
Formalize <b>agreements</b>	All levels: WHO, regional centers of disease control
Maintain <b>efficiency</b>	Inclusiveness, flexibility and collaboration
Scientific repository of guidance and tools	Improve risk management planning and capabilities in states
Continue providing comprehensive package	Standards setting, resource mobilization and implementation activities
Maintain a <b>balance</b>	Formulate recommendations, develop tools and measures to support implementation

**Outcomes Assembly 41 (Resolution 41.12)** 

- Directs ICAO to strengthen its crisis management capacity, including by establishing a crisis response framework and mechanism based on the experience gained during the COVID-19 crisis
- *Directs* ICAO to explore means to formalize the governance of the CAPSCA framework
- *Directs* ICAO to continue to engage with WHO and other relevant organizations establishing formalized collaboration agreements to strengthen CAPSCA and public health related Facilitation activities





### **Outcomes Assembly 41 (Resolution 41.12)**

Directs ICAO to continue to **collaborate** with the WHO and other public health groups, with other relevant aviation medicine and other relevant specialist medical organizations, with Planning and Implementation Regional Groups (PIRGs) and the Regional Aviation Safety Groups (RASGs) and working with the Air Navigation Commission, with aviation subject matter expert groups including such as the Personnel Training and Licensing Panel, and the Safety Management Panel to enable the sharing of information and resources for purposes of global harmonization relating to the prevention and management of public health emergencies





### **Outcomes Assembly 41 (Resolution 41.12)**

- Approves the development of an Aviation Health Management Plan by ICAO supporting implementation efforts of comprehensive management of health in aviation, by consolidating the various references to medical and health-related SARPs contained in the Annexes to the Convention into a comprehensive repository for the management of health in aviation
- Directs ICAO to give duly consideration to the development of a Procedures for Air Navigation Services (PANS) – Health in order to further support States in implementing health-related ICAO SARPs





### **Outcomes Assembly 41 (Resolution 41.13)**

- Directs the Council to establish a crisis response policy and disaster risk reduction strategy in aviation that would institutionalize and guide the Organizations strategic approach and tactical responses to aviation-specific crises that could affect the safety or continuity of international civil aviation
- Directs the Council to assist States in implementing disaster risk reduction strategies in aviation with priority given to Least Developed Countries (LDCs), Landlocked Developing Countries (LLDCs) and Small Island Developing States (SIDS)





### **Outcomes Assembly 41 (Resolution 41.13)**

- Instructs the Secretary General to continue working collaboratively within the United Nations System to ensure timely, coordinated and high-quality assistance to all States where disaster losses pose a threat to people's health and development
- Instructs the Secretary General to ensure that ICAO participate, when applicable and in alignment with its Strategic Objectives, in appropriate mechanisms put in place to support the cross-sectorial implementation of the Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015–2030 and the United Nations Plan of Action on Disaster Risk Reduction for Resilience.


