To showcase best practices in aeronautical information services adapted competency model in UAE.





THE AIM WORKING GROUP ACTIVITIES



Background

- ➤ The former AIS-AIM Study Group delivered a training manual in 2011.
- > The training manual had to be rewritten to incorporate the CBTA.
- ➤ The Training Manual Focus Group FG-TM was tasked to develop guidance material for competency-based training and assessment in the AIM domain.
- ➤ It was agreed to closely align the AIM Training Manual with the ATCO Training Manual.
- ➤ The first edition (2023) of ICAO Doc 9991 Manual on Aeronautical Information Services Training has been published on ICAO portal.
