## PART I - HISTORY OF THE MEETING

#### 1. PLACE AND DURATION

1.1 The First Meeting of the MIDANPIRG CNS/ATM/IC/SG was held at the ICAO MID Regional Office in Cairo, Egypt from 5 to 9 November 2001.

## 2. OPENING

- Mr. A. Zerhouni, ICAO Regional Director welcomed all the delegates to Cairo and wished the Meeting every success in its deliberations. He emphasized that short and medium term strategies were the basis for the CNS/ATM business including activities within the MID region. Mr. Zerhouni furthered stressed that coordination and interface between MID and other ICAO Regions (AFI, APAC and EUR) specifically in fields of harmonization of a number of elements of CNS/ATM Regional Plans were initiated with the ASIA and EUR partners. However, finance, budgetary, and legal and institution matters required further coordination. In the same context, the ICAO Global Air Navigation Conference proposed for year 2003 was featured as the next momentum after the World Wide CNS/ATM Conference held in Rio in 1998. MIDANPIRG, as well as other PIRGS will have a sizeable role in the preparation the coming Conference.
- 2.2 Mr. M. O. Al-Alawi, Director General ATS, Presidency of Civil Aviation, Saudi Arabia, the chairman of the meeting also welcomed all the participants to the meeting and concurred with the opening remarks of Mr. A. Zerhouni. He expressed his hope for a fruitful dialogue among the experts of the Sub-Group
- 2.3 Mr. M R. Khonji, Deputy ICAO Regional Director explained that the CNS/ATM/IC/SG/1 meeting was established by the MIDANPIRG/6 Meeting Decision 6/27 (New Title and Revised Term of reference for the CNS/ATM Sub-Group) and that it followed-up the work already done by the CNS/ATM Sub-Group. However, the task had moved from planning to implementation, even though planning might still be required (Terms of Reference of the CNS/ATM/IC/SG is attached as **Appendix A** to the History of the Meeting).
