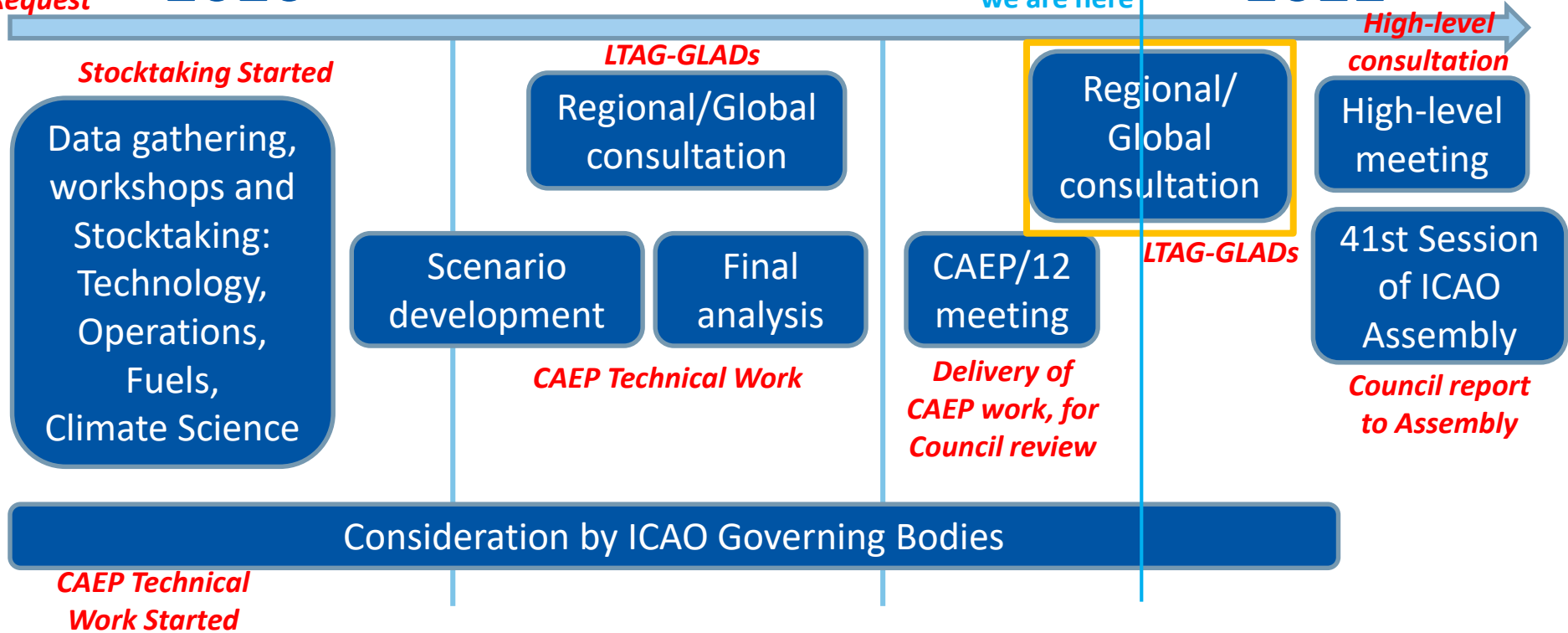

Action on Climate Change outside ICAO

- Global action on climate change is being taken through a number of processes, including:





High-Level Meeting and 2022 Stocktaking

- **High-Level Meeting on LTAG – from 20 to 22 July 2022**
 - Objective: consider the CO₂ emissions reduction scenarios and options for LTAG, its means of implementation and the monitoring of progress.
- **2022 ICAO Stocktaking – from 18 to 19 July 2022**
 - To be held before the High-Level meeting on LTAG
 - Objectives: Share the latest innovations on technology, operations and fuels, and complement information available to the High-level Meeting.
- **More information on these events to be shared via State Letters**



- **ICAO Council (late August/early September 2022):**
 - To be held after the High Level Meeting (HLM) on LTAG
 - Objectives: consider the outcomes of the HLM, and deliberate on the Assembly Working Paper on LTAG
- **ICAO 41st Assembly (from 27 September 2022):**
 - The ICAO Assembly will consider the progress of the work on exploring the feasibility of a long term global aspirational goal for international aviation. (Ref.: SA 41/2 – 22/21)
