- 1. In WP/11 it is mentioned that the limited availability and/or utilization of infrastructure at airports has led to serious problems notably in the form of flight delays.
- 2. It is worth to mention in this context that capacity constraints can lead to two other serious problems with significant economic implications:
 - a) decreasing quality of service at terminals (passenger and/or cargo terminals); and
 - b) decreasing level of competition between air carriers.
