FUTURE TASKS FOR THE ASIA PACIFIC ATN TRANSITION TASK FORCE

Summary

This Working Paper identifies future work tasks for the Asia Pacific ATN Transition Task Force to consider.

1 Introduction

The ATNTTF Working Group B identified a number of other tasks that will need to be addressed as part of the ATN Transition Task Force to assist with a smooth progression towards implementing the ATN within the Asia Pacific region.

2 Discussion

During the first meeting of the ATNTTF Working Group B, the work group developed a list of additional tasks that needed to be addressed by the ATN Transition Task Force. These tasks are identified as follows:

- Development of a Router ICD
- Development of a Routing policy (IDRP)
- Development of Directory Services
- Development of an AMHS ICD
- Development of an AIDC ICD

Some of these topics will need to be addressed as a matter of urgency to ensure that those States who have already started their implementation programs can take any necessary actions before completing their work programs. These areas include defining the Router ICD and the AMHS ICD. These two documents will assist in a cohesiveness approach to ensuring compatibility is maintained between all States when transitioning to the ATN.

3 Recommendations

The meeting is invited to discuss the above list identified by Working Group B and to determine whether or not they should be recommended for inclusion into the ATN Transition Task Force Subject/Task List.
