## **Aerodromes Developments**

## **AERODROME CERTIFICATION AND AUDITS**

(Presented by the Secretariat)

#### SUMMARY

This paper presents the latest information reported to ICAO in relation to the implementation of aerodrome certification in States in the CAR Region. The Meeting is invited to update the information for States and Territories in the Central Caribbean Region. The paper also presents to the Meeting for information the draft work plan for ICAO preparatory activities for the USOAP audits in Aerodromes.

### 1. Introduction

1.1 A status report on aerodrome certification implementation based on information provided by States at regional meetings and in response to an ICAO implementation follow-up letter sent to States / Territories is included in **Appendix A** to this paper.

1.2 The C/CAR/WG at its  $2^{nd}$  meeting held in Haiti in February 2002 adopted the following Decision:

# DECISION 2/18 FOLLOW UP TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF AERODROME CERTIFICATION IN THE C/CAR STATES/TERRITORIES

That the C/CAR Working Group follows up on the compliance of the aerodrome certification requirement on behalf of States/Territories of the C/CAR States, for which a table was prepared shown in the Appendix A to this part of the Report.

1.3 GREPECAS at its 11<sup>th</sup> meeting held in Brazil in December 2002 adopted the following Conclusion:

# CONCLUSION 11/11 AERODROME CERTIFICATION IMPLEMENTATION

That States,

- a) should urgently implement the aerodrome certification process in order to be compliant with the new standard by 27 November 2003; and
- b) provide an implementation status report to the AGA/AOP/SG/3 Meeting in September 2003.

1.4 The Draft Preparatory Work Plan for the expansion of the ICAO USOAP to Aerodromes is presented in **Appendix B** to this paper.

### 2. Action by the Meeting

2.1 The Meeting is invited to note the contents of this paper and take any action it considers appropriate to further encourage regional cooperation and the timely implementation by States/Territories of the aerodrome certification requirement. Furthermore, it is requested that States participating in this meeting complete the table included in **Appendix A** to this paper with up-to-date information corresponding to their respective State/Territories, and submit this to the Secretariat during the Meeting to enable the results to be presented in the meeting report.




