FUTURE WORK PROGRAMME

SUMMARY

This paper presents proposals for the future work programme of APANPIRG and its contributory bodies for consideration by the Group.

1. **INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 In accordance with the procedures of APANPIRG as set out in its Procedural Handbook, at each of its meetings, the Group should endeavour to agree on the date and duration of its next meeting.
- 1.2 In order to allow the contributory bodies to review the various air navigation problems in the ASIA/PAC regions at regular intervals as may be required and recommend solutions, it was agreed that APANPIRG should meet once a year (APANPIRG/1 Report).

2. **DISCUSSION**

- 2.1 It was agreed earlier that the future meetings of APANPIRG will be scheduled taking into consideration the ANC/Council programme, so that the review of APANPIRG reports by the ANC/Council could be achieved without delay, thus facilitating timely follow-up action by the States and the Secretariat.
- 2.2 In relation to periodicity and duration of APANPIRG meetings, APANPIRG/14 confirmed that the periodicity and duration of APANPIRG meetings were appropriate as it provided continuity, value, flexibility and focus in ensuring the implementation of regional air navigation systems. This aspect was determined taking into account the established criteria such as the additional responsibilities delegated from RAN meetings to PIRGs, the need to allow enough time for development between each PIRG meeting and the need to conduct activities in the most cost effective manner with the minimum of formality and documentation. The Air Navigation Commission during the 5th Meeting of its 165st Session on 27 January 2004 took note of this aspect.

- 2.3 APANPIRG/14 developed a tentative meeting schedule for 2004 and 2005. According to this APANPIRG/16 was scheduled to be held in August 2005. The meeting schedule of the contributory bodies were reviewed by the respective Sub-Groups and revised dates have been suggested.
- 2.4 The suggested schedule of meetings for 2005 and 2006 given below is based on the normal practice followed so far:
