SUMMARY

1. Introduction

1.1 At the 26th Meeting of the E/CAR Informal Working Group, an E/CAR Regional ATM/CNS Committee was established with Special Terms of Reference.

1.2 States were required to reactivate their National ATM/CNS Committees and forward the name of their nominee to this Committee to IACL no later than end-September 2002. Thereafter, a Meeting would have been convened to discuss the Terms of Reference Work Program and report to the 27th Meeting of the E/CAR IWG.

1.3 At the 27th Meeting of the E/CAR IWG each State nominated their member(s) to the Regional Committee.

2. Discussion

2.1 During October 2003 and January and May 2004 the Committee Members were reminded by e-mail of the above references and on submitting updates and/or amendments to their respective National Plan and Timetable in order to update the E/CAR/ ATM Plan. This was a pre-requisite to convene a meeting of the Regional Committee for the Implementation Procedures discussion. Unfortunately, lack of responses precluded the hosting of the Meeting.

2.2 On August 27th 2004, the E/CAR ATM/CNS Plan, the States' National Plans, Terms of Reference and Work Program were forwarded to the Committee Members for updates and/or amendments.
