- To avoid taxation




Is it a Cost Recovery Policy?

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Charges or Taxes?

- Charges to recover costs of facilities and services for civil aviation
- Taxes to raise national or local government revenues





Cost Basis for Charges

- A general principle ... users to pay their share
- Full costs
- Limited traffic ... less than full costs
- Developing regions ... justified to ask international air carriers to contribute
- Costs for regulation imposed on ANSPs



Charging Systems



- Include all air navigation services (ATM, CNS, MET, AIS and SAR)
- SAR: permanent civil establishment of equipment and personnel
- The ATM provider collects charges
- Two kinds of charges (route charge and approach/aerodrome control charge)



Multinational facilities/services

- CNS/ATM elements of a multinational character
- Guidelines in all regional plans
- States contribute to financing and recover it through their route charges
- Other forms of international cooperation ... Joint Financing Arrangements etc.
