Ms. Jane Hupe is the Chief of the Environmental Unit in ICAO's Air Transport Bureau and the Secretary of ICAO's Committee on Aviation Environmental Protection (CAEP). Her responsibilities include the management of the ICAO Environmental Programme, the CAEP, and coordination of work in the field of aviation and the environment with other International Organizations, such as UNFCCC, IMO, UNEP, and ISO.

Ms. Hupe has been in the forefront of ICAO's efforts to define and promote

policies and standards for aviation environmental protection. She advises the ICAO Council on recommendations to minimize the impact of aviation on the environment and cooperates directly in other international fora on environmental issues related to aviation within and outside the UN family.

Prior to 1998, Ms. Hupe worked as a consultant with ICAO's Technical Cooperation Bureau and for 15 years with the Brazilian Civil Aviation Authorities.
