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ICAO's studies on the financial situation of airports and ANSPs

- Regular ICAO surveys (every twothree years) via State letter
- Supplemented by ICAO's Air Transport Reporting Forms J, K and L, as well as information available on various websites
- Most recent report covers 2007:

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Report 2007: providers' income, expenses, investments data

- Airports: 70 States with 412 airports (Africa/Middle East: 13 States with 52 airports)
- Air navigation services: 63 States (Africa/Middle East: 8 States)
- Insufficient data from African States to evaluate the financial situation of airports and ANSPs on a regional basis
- Additional problem: few airports and ANSPs have data available on websites



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Airports - Africa/Middle East (13 States with 52 airports) reported:

Income USD m 1,446 *

Expenses USD m 1,041

• Profit USD m 405

 Investments USD m 1,414
 but 24 of the 52 airports did not recover all their costs, while income exceeded expenses at the other 28 airports

^{*} non-aeronautical revenues only 28% of total income



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ANSPs - Africa/Middle East (8 States) reported:

Income USD m 288

Expenses USD m 194

Profit USD m 94

• Investments USD m 2 (?)

2 ANSPs did not recover all their costs, while income of the other 6 ANSPs exceeded their expenses



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Conclusion

- Coverage of Africa/Middle East insufficient
- To improve the situation, States are encouraged to:
 - report to ICAO airport and air navigation traffic and financial statistics
 - participate in the ICAO surveys (i.e. report data as requested in State letters)
 - make use of the Internet for reporting purposes
