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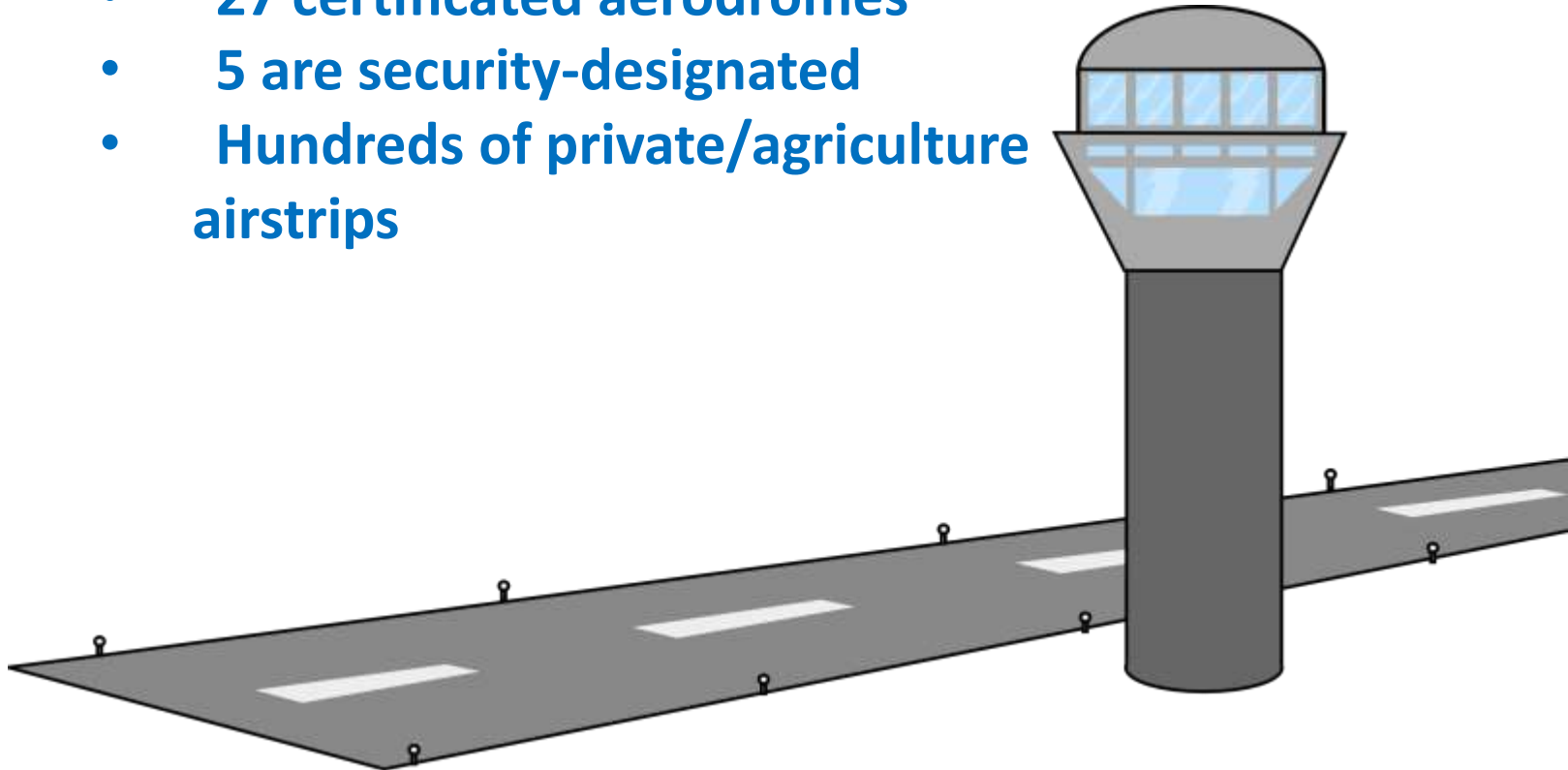

inaccessible

1996: Interview by TVNZ.
Said she was not coping
with NZ society & would
like to return to Somalia

voice them

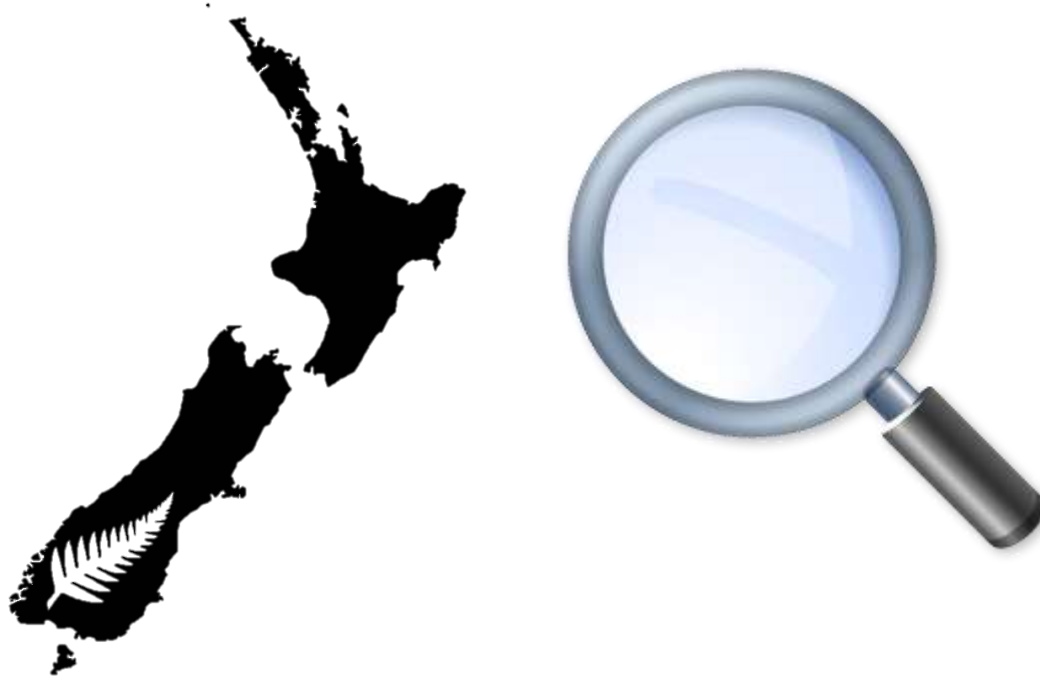
Allocated seat 7A but

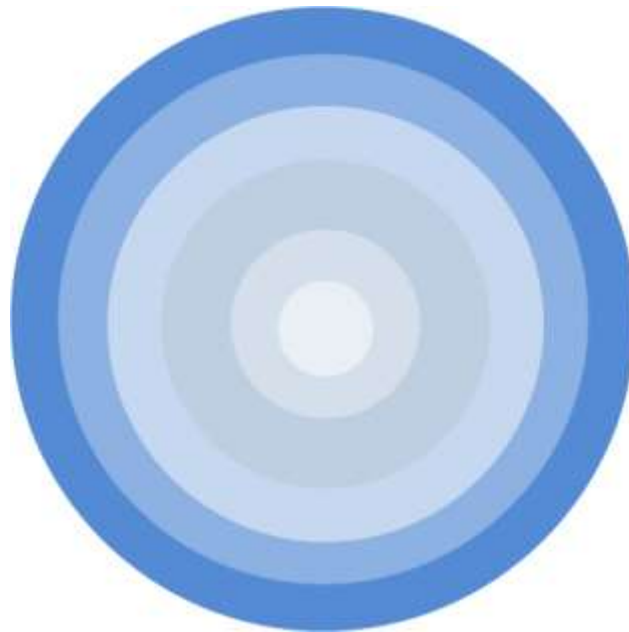

See It
