But also to investors, to industry and to governments.

An agreement that will bring new opportunities, mobilise financial resources, and open up new markets.

Of course, <u>global</u> action and <u>collaboration</u> are key.

No country can be left behind.

By bringing together <u>knowledge</u> and <u>expertise</u>, ICAO can act as a matchmaker and play a pivotal supporting role in these efforts.

So this week, let's bring together all of the innovative and creative thinking that the aviation industry has always been known for.

Let's come to an agreement on an ambitious framework.

I wish you all every success, and I look forward to an <u>outstanding</u> outcome!
