### CORSIA is top-of-mind right now...

- A complex development process
- First time done in aviation / first time done anywhere
- New to a lot of us...
  - But once in place, it will become part of regular business for operators and authorities alike
- But it is not **the** solution to our climate challenge
  - It is an important first step for the medium term
- We need to reduce emissions, not offset them

#### We must ensure that CORSIA is robust

- Emissions units criteria / TAB process is vital
- Airlines will fund at least \$40bn in climate projects over the course of the scheme
- We must ensure that the investments are high-quality and fulfill the criteria adopted
- This is about climate protection, not politics!

#### Key ask for governments

- Reaffirm commitment to CORSIA at 40<sup>th</sup> ICAO Assembly
  - Industry fully supports CORSIA
- Ensure offsets are robust and high quality
- CORSIA remains the measure for international flights
  - Implement CORSIA the way it is designed
  - Global standards boost ambition globally
- Volunteer! a wave of announcements ahead of A40!
- Help deliver actual reductions in CO<sub>2</sub>:
  - Sustainable fuels deployment policy
  - ATM system upgrades in line with ICAO ASBUs
