**Assembly Resolution 37-19** 

Encourages States to submit their action plans outlining their respective policies and actions

Invites States that choose to prepare an action plan to submit it to ICAO preferably by June 2012

Requests the Council to provide guidance and other technical assistance for the preparation of States' Action Plans





- Further encourages States to submit their voluntary action plans outlining their respective policies and actions
- Invites States that choose to prepare or update their action plans to submit them to ICAO as soon as possible, preferably by the end of June 2015 and once every three years thereafter;
- Encourages States that already submitted their action plans to share information contained in their action plans and built partnerships with other member States in order to support those States that have not prepared their action plans;
- Encourages States to make their action plans available to the public, taking into account the commercial sensitivity of information contained in States' action plans;
- Requests **ICAO to continue to provide guidance** and other technical assistance for the preparation of States' action plans prior to the end of June 2015, in order for States to conduct their necessary studies and to voluntarily submit their action plans to ICAO;

### **Action Plan Contents**


A planning and reporting tool for States to communicate information on their activities to address CO<sub>2</sub> emissions from International Aviation to ICAO

- Data that will allow future progress toward the global aspirational goals, to be assessed by ICAC







73 States, representing around 82% international RTK , submitted a first action plan as of March 2014




- 73 States submitted an Action Plan



### Mitigation measures selected in Action Plans- By Regions






Share of International Total 2012 RTK

However, improvements are needed




