Yesterday and Today

- Brazil has been a member of CAEP since its formation in 1983
- Today Brazil leads two of the CAEP working groups:
 - ACCS (Aviation Carbon Calculator Support Group) AFTF (Alternative Fuels Task Force)
- And has made technical experts available to five others
 - WG1 (Noise Technical)
 - WG2 (Airports and Operations)
 - WG3 (Emissions Technical)
 - FESG (Forecasting and Economic Analysis Support Group)
 - MDG (Modelling and Databases Group)











- Aviation Carbon Calculator Support Group is responsible for the methodology used by the ICAO Carbon Emissions Calculator
- Current tasks include:
 - Enhancements to the passenger calculator
 - Methodology for CO₂ emissions from air cargo
 - Report on ways to collect data on offsetting
 - Methodology to account for offsets in the carbon calculator











- Alternative Fuels Task Force is a newlycreated group in CAEP
- Initial tasks include:
 - Life-cycle analysis methodology
 - Alternative fuels projection
 - Range of emissions from use of alternative fuels to 2050
















- New Noise Standard Chapter 14
