Mr. Georgios Sourvanos is the National Continuous Monitoring Coordinator of Greece for the ICAO USOAP Program.

Georgios was born in Athens, Greece in 1958. In 1982 he got a diploma in Mechanical and Marine Engineering from the National Technical University of Athens.

After his military service, in 1985 he joined the Hellenic CAA where he held several posts. After having served in positions regarding the design and maintenance of electromechanical installations, as well as the operation of airports, he joined the Flight Standards Division, where he served in all domains (personnel licensing, operations, and airworthiness).

He has been the Head of the Airworthiness Section of HCAA since 2003. In 2009 and 2015 Georgios also held in parallel the post of Acting Director of the Flight Standards Division of HCAA.

Being already an advisor from 2002, Georgios became in 2012 the Alternate Member of Greece in the Management Board of EASA. He is also Member of the EASA Committee, Member of the Air Safety Committee and the National Standardization Coordinator for EASA inspections. He is also a member of the EU Group for analyzing the findings of USOAP of third countries.

He is a fellow of the Technical Chamber of Greece.
