- explore means to formalize the governance of the CAPSCA framework
- continue to engage with WHO and other relevant organizations establishing formalized collaboration agreements to strengthen CAPSCA and public health related Facilitation activities


- continue to collaborate with the WHO and other public health groups, with other relevant aviation medicine and other relevant specialist medical organizations, with Planning and Implementation Regional Groups (PIRGs) and the Regional Aviation Safety Groups (RASGs)
- enable the sharing of information and resources for purposes of global harmonization relating to the prevention and management of public health emergencies by working with the Air Navigation Commission, with aviation subject matter expert groups including such as the Personnel Training and Licensing Panel, and the Safety Management Panel to
- give duly consideration to the development of a Procedures for <u>Air Navigation Services (PANS)</u> <u>Health</u> in order to further support States in implementing health-related ICAO SARPs
