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ICAO's Work in the legal field after the 41st Assembly

ICAO Legal Committee's Current Work Programme

- 1 Review of the ICAO Rules for the Settlement of Differences
- 2 International legal aspects of unmanned (pilotless) aircraft operations and integration into civil aviation
- 3 Processes and procedures for States to fulfil their obligations under Article 12 of the Chicago Convention
- 4 Acts or offences of concern to the international aviation community, including cyber threats, that may not be adequately covered by the existing air law instruments
- 5 Promotion of the **ratification** of international air law instruments
- 6 Study of the international legal issues relating to **global satellite systems and services** supporting international air navigation services
- 7 Consideration of guidance on **conflicts of interest**
- 8 Implementation of Article 21 of the Chicago Convention



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Item 1: Review of the Rules for the Settlement of Differences

- 2018 (LC37) Included in Legal Committee's work programme [priority item 2]
- May 2019 Working Group for the Review of the ICAO Rules for the Settlement of Differences (WG-RRSD) commenced
- WG-RRSD held 6 meetings (4 virtual) between May 2019 & Jan 2022
- WG-RRSD **progress report** presented to LC38 (Mar 2022) highlighted areas of the Rules identified for possible revision and the status of deliberations (i.e. areas where a high level of agreement has already been attained and areas requiring further consideration) [elevated to priority item 1]
- A-41 welcomed the progress made by the WG-RRSD

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- 7th Meeting held in-person at ICAO HQ (Montreal) in Jan 2023; 8th & 9th also in 2023
- WG-RRSD aiming for revised rules to be sufficiently mature for consideration by **LC39** (Spring 2024)



<u>Item 2</u>: International Legal Aspects of unmanned (pilotless) aircraft operations and integration into civil aviation</u>

- 2013 (A38) Assembly added Study of RPA legal issues to Legal Committee's work programme
- 2018 (LC37) Working Group to study pilotless aircraft operations legal aspects and integration issues established but work is on hold due to budgetary constraints
- 2019 (A40) Assembly supported establishment of Secretariat Study Group to provide an interface between ICAO's legal and technical work on pilotless aircraft
- Aug 2021 SSG-LIPA's 1st meeting established 2 Sub-groups (i) Subgroup on Compliance with the Chicago Convention (ii) Subgroup on Liability & Security.
- Sub-group (i) met virtually in early 2022 to consider ANB's proposal for an Assembly resolution like A40-4 on Certificates of airworthiness, certificates of competency and licences of flight crews



<u>Item 6</u>: Study of the international legal issues relating to global satellite systems and services supporting international air navigation services

- Previous work led to Assembly Resolutions A32-19 on a Charter on the rights and obligations of States relating to GNSS Services and A32-20 on the Long-term legal framework to govern the implementation of GNSS
- No major legal work within ICAO since & Secretariat continues to observe for new developments relating to this subject
- 2022 (A41 Legal Commission) Some States requested that work be considered. A suggestion to review previous work and to consider SARPs developed. Secretariat on lookout for concrete proposals from States.



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Item 8: Implementation of Article 21 of the Chicago Convention

- Article 21 of the Chicago Convention provides the basis for the **exchange of aircraft registration**, **ownership and control data** between States
- 2017 summer LEB questionnaire distributed to States

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- Article 21 Task Force held 2 meetings in September 2017 and April 2018
- March 2022 Council adopted a Model Certificate of De-registration of Aircraft in Annex 7 Aircraft Registration and Nationality Marks
