1. CORRECT USE OF ARTICLE 83 BIS

BACKROUND

Protocol

• Protocol on Article 83 *bis* approved by the Assembly in 1980 at A23, entered into force on 20 June 1997.

Rationale

• Lease, charter or interchange of an aircraft can lead to the State of Registry being different from State of the Operator and to split oversight responsibilities.

Article 83 bis Task Force

• 5 Recommendations

Wide Participation

• Currently 180 parties to the Protocol.




1. CORRECT USE OF ARTICLE 83 BIS



Article 83 bis Transfer of certain functions and duties

- a) Notwithstanding the provisions of Articles 12, 30, 31 and 32 a), when an aircraft registered in a contracting State is operated pursuant to an agreement for the lease, charter or interchange of the aircraft or any similar arrangement by an operator who has his principal place of business or, if he has no such place of business, his permanent residence in another contracting State, the State of registry may, by agreement with such other State, transfer to it all or part of its functions and duties as State of registry in respect of that aircraft under Articles 12, 30, 31 and 32 a). The State of registry shall be relieved of responsibility in respect of the functions and duties transferred.
- b) The transfer shall not have effect in respect of other contracting States before either the agreement between States in which it is embodied has been registered with the Council and made public pursuant to Article 83 or the existence and scope of the agreement have been directly communicated to the authorities of the other contracting State or States concerned by a State party to the agreement.

Benefits to using Article 83 bis

Facilitation

proper supervision even when the aircraft is based at a distance from the State of Registry

- Improved oversight of aircraft maintenance;
- Harmonized qualification and training of crew;
- Dry leases vs. wet leases.

Efficiency

reduced costs for both the operator and the State of Registry

Responsibility

responsible way to maintain standards of supervision whilst enabling the operator to have flexibility

• Law of the State of the Operator applied by the State of the Operator

- State of Registry
- State of Operator

- Duration of the agreement
- Termination provisions



SAFETY OVERSIGHT RESPONSIBILITIES

Coordination between the State of the Operator and the State of Registry

Responsibilities of the State of the Operator

- Training of Inspectors
- Inspection Guides
- Continuing Airworthiness Responsibilities
- Assistance to the Operator
- Reporting to the Sate of Registry
- No delegation of functions without agreement of State of Registry

Responsibilities of the State of Registry

- Monitoring safety oversight of the Sate of the Operator
- Airworthiness Responsibilities
- Training of Inspectors
- Assistance to owner/lessor
- Responsibilities on termination of the agreement

Responsibilities of Third States

- Legislation to account for transfer of functions and duties
- Training of inspectors

3. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Article 83: Obligation to Register Article 83 bis Agreement

Rules for Registration

- Agreements to be registered as soon as possible
- Agreement may be registered by either party
- Submission to include:
 - Certified true copy of the agreement
 - The Agreement Summary
- Translation if original agreement or Agreement Summary is not in an ICAO working language




Number of States with Focal Points




