- WHO Constitution (Article 2)
- International Health Regulations of 2005 (including Annex 9 on facilitation of the Chicago Convention).
- ICAO-WHO Memorandum of Understanding establishing a framework of cooperation (2022)



ICAO-WHO collaboration on COVID-19

- Advocacy for the application, adjustment and lifting of travel measures to be riskbased and evidence-informed
- IHR Emergency Committee on COVID-19
- Global technical guidance
 - Joint Statement on COVID19 public health measures on aviation, 11 March 2020
 - Joint Statement on prioritization of COVID-19 vaccination for seafarers and aircrew, 25 March 2021



ICAO-WHO collaboration on COVID-19

- ICAO input to WHO guidance
 - Updated WHO recommendations for international traffic in relation to COVID-19, February 2020
 - WHO guidance document, Policy Considerations for Implementing a Risk-Based Approach to International Travel in the Context of COVID-19, July 2021.

 - ICAO Manual on COVID-19 Cross-border Risk Management
 - CART COVID-19 Take-off guidance

- Collaborative Arrangement for the Prevention and Management of Public Health Events in Civil Aviation (CAPSCA)
- Digital health and innovation
 - WHO Technical Consultation on Interoperable Digital Health Trust Networks (April 2022)
 - WHO Technical Consultation on Digitizing Trusted Personal Health Records (January 2023).



New global health architecture for emergency response

- o Intergovernmental Negotiating Body, tasked with drafting a Pandemic Accord
- Intergovernmental Working Group to consider targeted amendments to the IHR
- Standing Committee on Health Emergency Prevention, Preparedness and Response
- Universal Health Periodic Review
- Director-General's ten proposals to strengthen the global health architecture for health emergency preparedness, response, and resilience
 - including a Global Health Emergency Council
