Note that the passport must be valid for 6 months and has a white background passport-size photo.</p>
<b>Health:</b>	<p>It is strongly recommended for participants to have travel insurance (including health) for the duration of their stay in UAE. Participants should ensure that their insurance is applicable in UAE. Furthermore, they should carry evidence of current health/hospitalization insurance such as cards that may be produced to health institutions should the need arise.</p>
<b>Weather:</b>	<p>Daytime temperatures will range from highs of 36°C to a balmy 26°C. Evening temperatures are set to drop to 27°C.</p>
<b>Local currency:</b>	<p>The official United Arab Emirates currency is the Emirati UAE Dirham (AED). Notes come in AED 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500 and 1,000 denominations. Most banks in the UAE operate from Monday to Friday, with Saturday and Sunday being the weekend days.</p>
<b>Electricity:</b>	<p>Standard voltage in UAE is 220V at a frequency of 50Hz. Participants are encouraged to ensure compatibility with their gadgets or to have international power adapters.</p>
