He is an ICAO certified Instructor, and a Universal Security Audit Programme Continuous Monitoring Approach (USAP-CMA) certified auditor, from which use to be one of the Team leader while based in ICAO Headquarters Montreal.

He is the liaison for the coordination and assistance between ICAO and the NAM/CAR States in Aviation Security and Facilitation issues; and in coordination with the Implementation, Support and Development (ISD-Sec) Branch and the Facilitation Section at ICAO Headquarters to organize and execute the ICAO's Regular Training Programme workshops and courses in the NAM/CAR Regional Aviation Security Centre (ASTCs) as well as the technical assistance programme when required by States and International organizations. He started his aeronautical career four decades ago as Flight Dispatcher and Operations Manager in *Lloyd Aéreo Boliviano Airlines*, where he worked for 20 years in various positions at Bolivian and South and North American Airports, including the Management of the Miami International Airport for more than a decade.

He is specialized in airport operations management and air carrier security matters, facilitation and dangerous goods. He was part of the Bolivian DGAC team who developed the Bolivian Aeronautical Regulations and obtained the aeronautical FAA categorization in Bolivia.
