Sam has managed Government initiatives touching all five of ICAO's Strategic Objectives, and he has significant experience in ICAO matters prior to joining the ICAO Council, particularly in the air transport and facilitation fields. He chaired the ICAO Facilitation Panel from 2012 to 2015, and has represented Australia at Assembly, in the Air Transport Regulation Panel, and at diplomatic conferences.

Beyond aviation, Sam has managed the delivery of essential services such as health and education in Australia's remote territories, and managed the Australian Government's engagement with local governments across the country. He has also worked in corporate and commercial law in Canada, and in government legal practice in Australia.
