




One ID Principles



Do more early

Passenger identity information is captured and authenticated as early as possible


Majority of passengers arrive at airports "Ready to Fly"



Interoperability


Stakeholder collaboration Development and adoption of global recommended practices and standards

Trust framework



Streamline

Identity information provided once for round trips and may persist across multiple trips



Passenger Centricity

Simplifies passenger processing Controls access to data

Information shared on a controlled need-to-know / authorized need to know basis



DTC to modernize air border

travel documents and authorizations prior to departure

- On behalf of the government of destination
- In the absence of a means for governments to verify such information
- However, airlines are not experts in document verification
- Decision is sometimes difficult to accept or refuse a passenger to board

Government issued DTC removes the constraints inherent with a 100% physical document

- Governments can authenticate the information prior to departure
- Reduces the risk of inadmissible passengers upon arrival
- Reduces the risk of fines to airlines in cases of transporting inappropriately documented passengers
- Facilitates and secures the issuance of travel authorizations
- Supports a contactless process
