

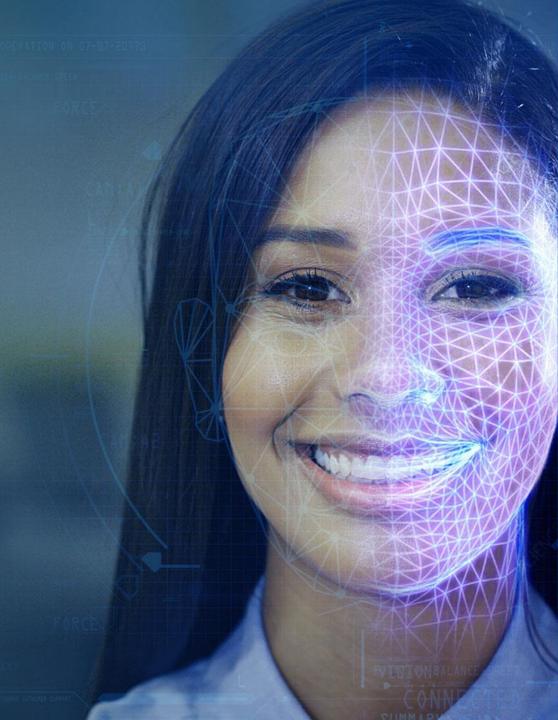

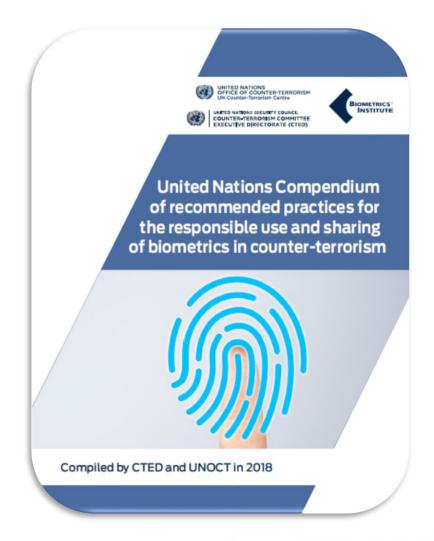

Linking a person to an activity, event, location or another person before, during or after an incident

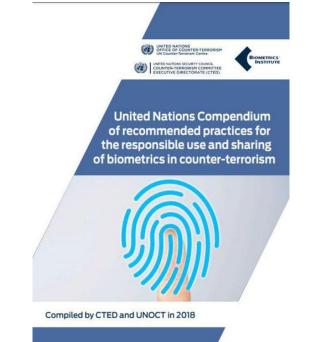
Linking one event to another event or multiple **events**

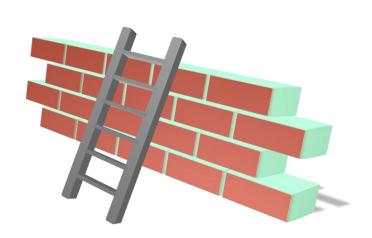

Main Global Implementation Challenges

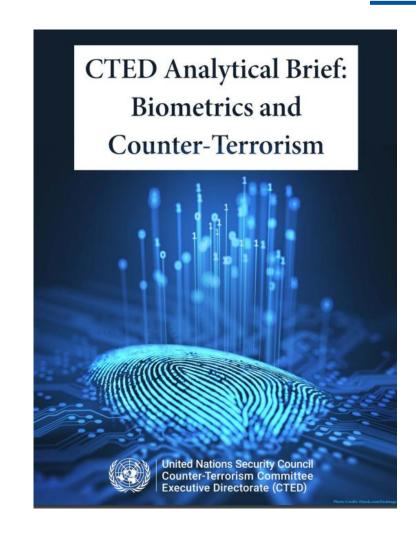
- Resources
