Those wishing to participate in any of the scheduled activities should pre-register with the Welcome Committee Coordinator, Ariane Proulx, by email at [aproulx@icao.int](mailto:aproulx@icao.int), indicating the activities they are interested in and providing full details (name, delegation, address, phone number, email, allergies/food restrictions). Upon arrival at Headquarters, it is **mandatory to pass at the Welcome Committee desk and fill in the corresponding registration stubs** which appear after the description of each activity outlined in this programme. **The access badges will also be delivered at the Welcome Committee desk.**

**Please note that for each activity a special registration deadline has been established for registration on-site. Please make sure that you carry your registration receipt with you on the day of the activity, as you will be asked to show it.**

Due to limited seating capacity on buses, **priority for registration will be given to visiting participants**. For resident participants, registrations will be taken from a separate list on a "first-come first-served" basis, **except in such cases** when a **Visiting** participant wishes to be accompanied by a **Resident** participant of its own Delegation, then the latter will be registered on the **Priority** list.

**DAY TOUR OF QUEBEC CITY AND MONTMORENCY FALLS**

*Host:* Government of Quebec

Québec, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, was founded by the French explorer Champlain in the early 17th century. It is the only North American city to have preserved its ramparts, together with the numerous bastions, gates and defensive works which still surround Old Québec. The Upper Town, built on the cliff, has remained the religious and administrative centre, with its churches, convents and other monuments like the Dauphine Redoubt, the Citadel and Château Frontenac. Together with the Lower Town and its ancient districts, it forms an urban ensemble which is one of the best examples of a fortified colonial city.

Upon arrival, you will have the chance to visit the beautiful Montmorency Falls Park, just a few minutes from downtown Québec City. The waterfalls are 83 m (272') tall, a full 30 m (99') higher than Niagara Falls. Follow the footpath along the top of the cliff to the suspended bridge, which affords a splendid view of the area. We will enjoy lunch at the Restaurant Baker.

We then depart for the Old Quebec. You will get off at the Château Frontenac and have the pleasure to stroll around the old part of the city and do some shopping.
