





Place of venue

The 2024 ICAO Green Airport Seminar will take place at the Grand Hyatt Athens Hotel, located in the central area of Athens City.

Working Hours


The event will run from 09:00 through 17:00, with coffee and lunch breaks.

Registration & Onsite Badge Collection

Registration will open on the 17th of April afternoon 17.00 -19.00 and on the 18th of April morning between 08.00 - 09.00 hours.

The badge collection of registered participants on site will take place simutaneously at the registration desk.

While there are no specific security requirements, the registered participants must present a valid ID for identification to receive their badges.



How to get to Athens

Flights to Athens Airport

Arrival and Transport

Plenty of options are available if you are landing at Athens Airport and looking for your way to downtown Athens. You may choose between airport taxis, metro, Suburban Railway and buses.

Athens Airport subway is the best choice for public transport. Fast services, frequent itineraries, and relatively affordable prices make the Athens metro a very popular transportation option. In a 5-minute walking distance from the terminal, the airport train station building is located at the Departures level and is connected to the main terminal via an elevated passageway. You can purchase a ticket either from the station's ticket offices or from the automatic vendor-paying machine.

The train journey to Syntagma Square is about 40 minutes, while Athens Airport Metro Line 3 departs from the airport every 35 minutes from 06:30 to 23:30.

Athens Airport to City Center by Bus

If you are looking for the cheapest transfer option from Athens Airport to Athens city center, then the Athens airport bus is for you. The X95 bus will get you to Syntagma Square in downtown Athens in about 60 minutes, depending on the congestion on the roads. Tickets are available from the airport ticket offices or on board, and the bus stop is located at the Arrivals level, between Exits 4 and 5. Click **here** for more information.

Hotel Accommodation



Power Supply


Greece there are two associated plug types, C and F. Plug type C is the plug that has two round pins, and plug type F is the plug that has two round pins with two earth clips on the side.

Greece operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.



Airport taxis

Athens airport taxis offer a set fare for the journey from Athens Airport to the center of Athens. Thus, during the day shift (05:00 am – 00:00 am), the taxi ride will cost you approximately $40 \in /42$, while during the nighttime, the price will rise approximately to $55 \in /58$. Passport and visa requirements

Passports

For EU citizens, a passport is not required an identity card with Latin characters is enough. For non-EU citizens, a valid passport is necessary to enter the country. If you lose your passport in Greece, the local police and the embassy of your home country must be contacted. It is recommended that you have a photocopy of your passport in order to complete the replacement process more quickly.

Visas

When arriving by plane to the airports of Greece (on the mainland or the islands), all citizens of foreign countries - except for the countries of the European Union, the USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and some more - need a visa to enter the country. 
