



Martin Dresner

PROFESSOR / ATRS PRESIDENT, UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND

Dresner has served on the faculty of the R.H. Smith School of Business at the University of Maryland since 1988, where he is currently Professor and Chair of the Logistics, Business and Public Policy Department. He received his Ph.D. in Policy Analysis from the Sauder School of Business at the University of British Columbia.

Dresner has published over 75 papers in refereed journals. Professionally, he is President of the Air Transport Research Society (ATRS) and is on the Scientific and Steering Committees of the World Conference on Transportation Research. Dresner sits on the editorial boards of several journals in the transportation, logistics and supply chain fields and is immediate past editor of *Research in Transportation Economics* and a former editor of *Transportation Journal*. Dresner has testified before the U.S. House Aviation Subcommittee, and has worked on consulting projects for a number of organizations, including the Maryland Aviation Administration, the Federal Aviation Administration and the U.S. Department of Energy.
