Toru Hasegawa was appointed Deputy Director, Economic Development, Air Transport Bureau of the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) in January 2015. He has been working in ICAO since 2000, where he served as Chief, Revenue and Product Management Section, an Assistant to Director, Air Transport Bureau, as well as an Economist in charge of economic policy and infrastructure management. Prior to joining ICAO, he worked at Northwest Airlines and the Nomura Research Institute in Japan. He holds a Ph.D., an MA and a BA in economics, all from Tokyo University, with specialization in industrial organization and applied economics of pricing theories. He has published eight books (in Japanese) on airline pricing and economics.
