Metroplex Overview

- The South Florida Metroplex Project developed procedures based on a region, rather than focusing on a single airport or set of procedures.
- The optimization plan takes into account all airports and airspace that support the South Florida area as well as how air traffic in those areas interact
- It considers a myriad of factors including safety, efficiency, access and environmental impact

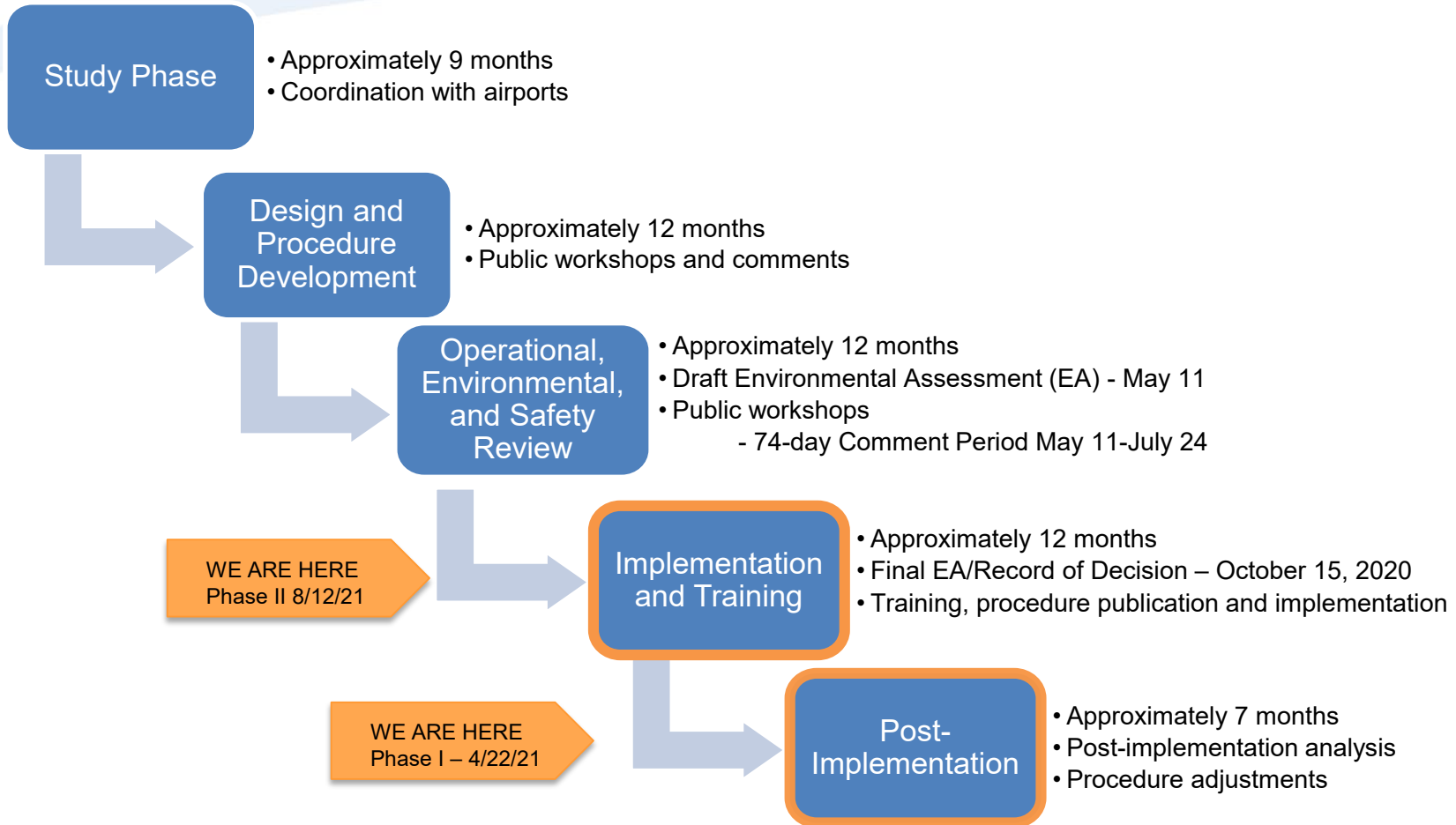
Metroplex Benefits

- New RNAV procedures designed to lessen interactions between flights serving different airports
 - Altitude restrictions designed to reduce conflicts between separate procedures
 - Allows more unrestricted climbs and Optimized Profile Descents (OPDs)
 - Provides more repeatable and predictable paths
 - Reduced vectoring

Status Update



August 12, 2021 Implementation

- 93 Procedures:
 - 76 procedures will be published and implemented
 - 17 procedures published on April 22, 2021 and NOTAMd NA will be implemented
 - STARs, SIDs, SIAPs, along with associated airspace changes
 - TMIs planned for seven days
 - Continuous review to allow gradual lifting
 - WX scenarios taken into consideration

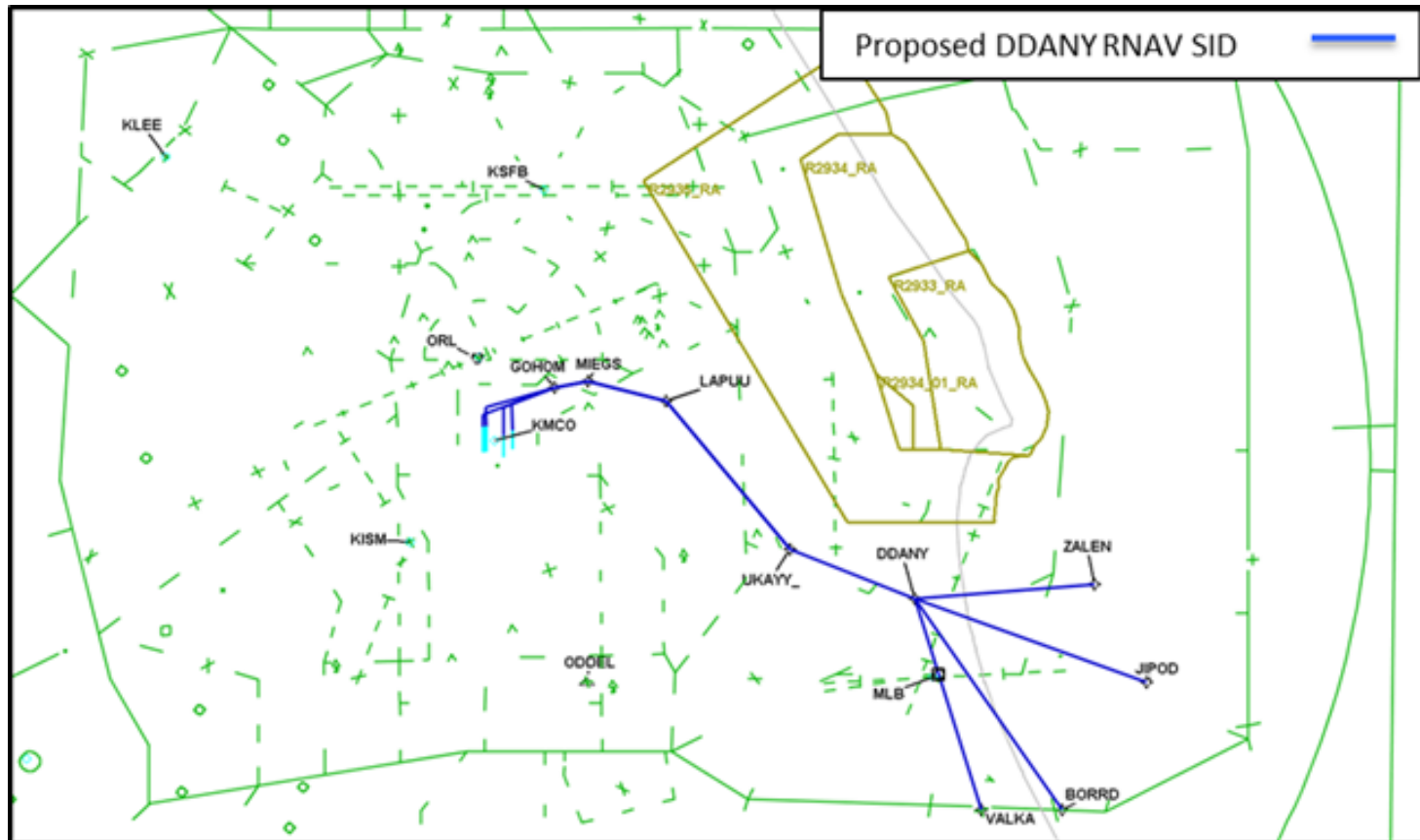

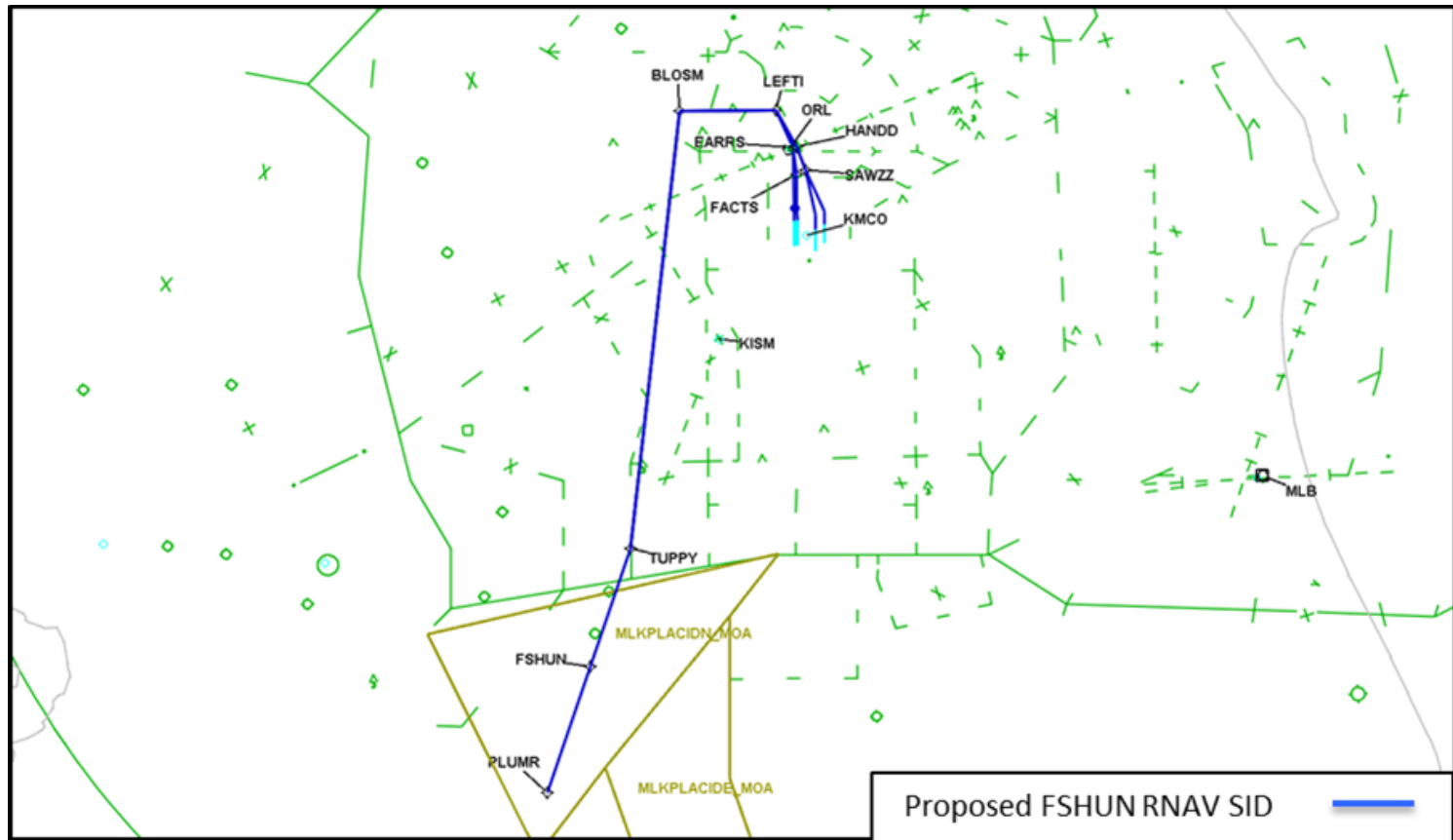

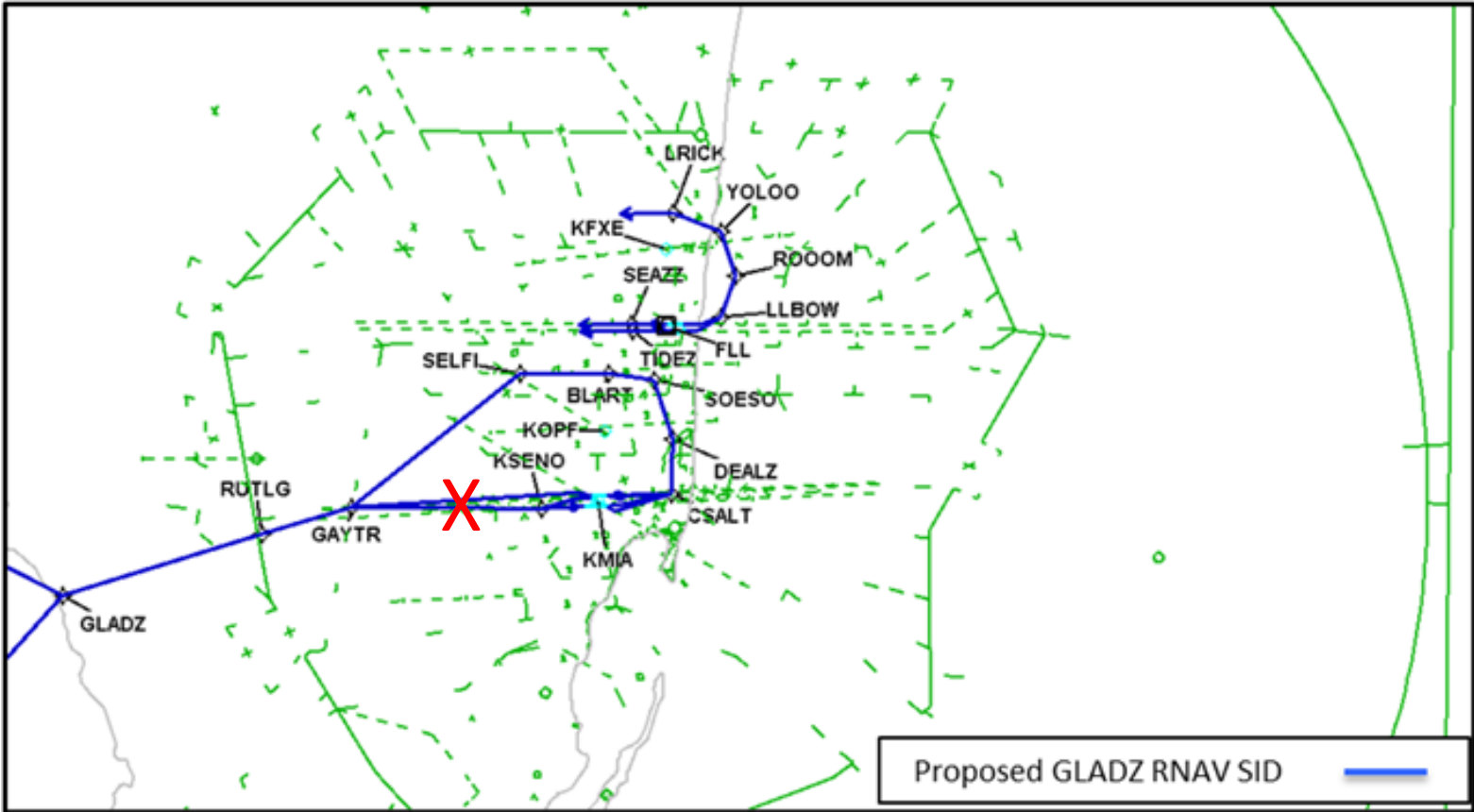
DDANY RNAV SID (Serves MCO)

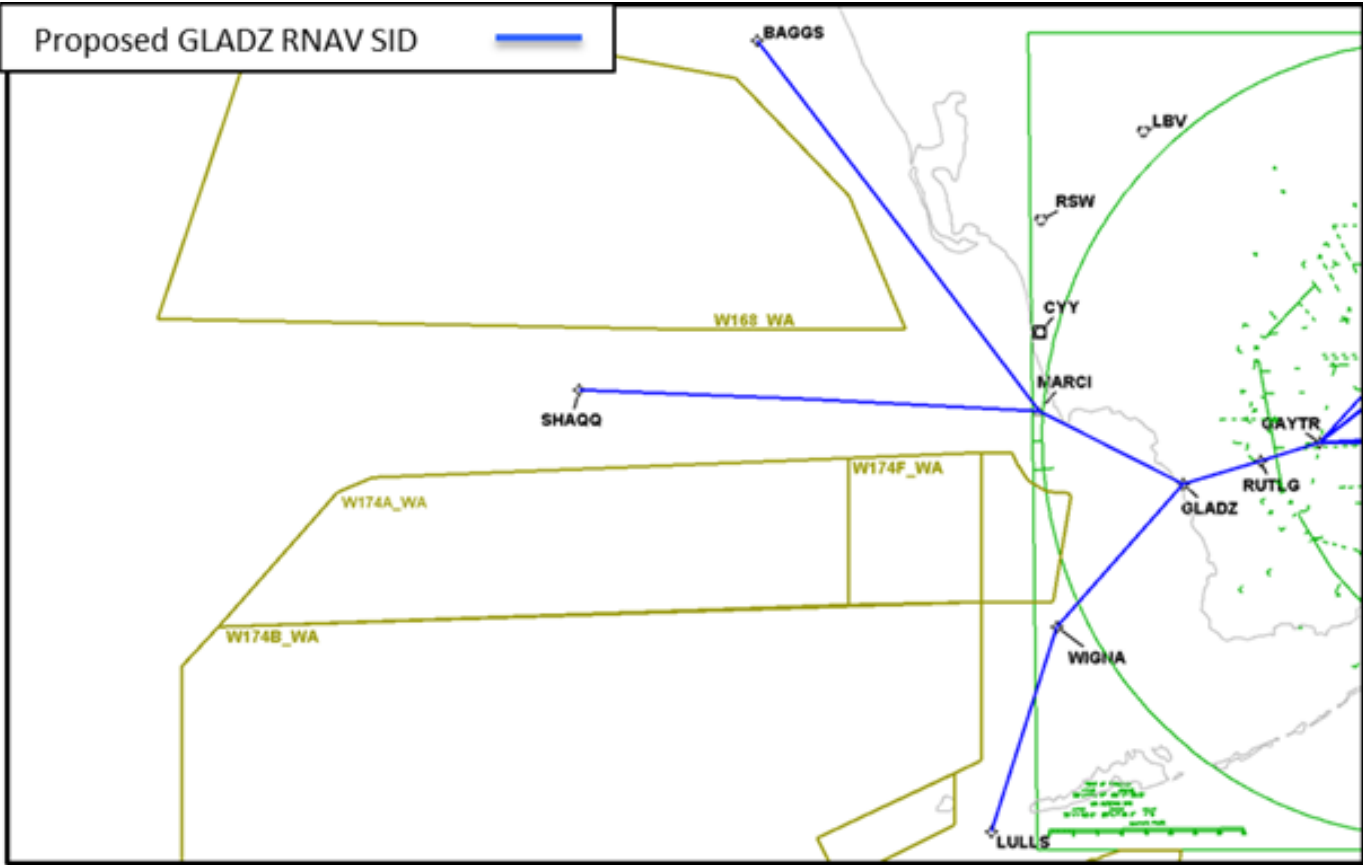


GLADZ RNAV SID/MIA East Operations Only (Serves MIA, FLL, OPF) Terminal View

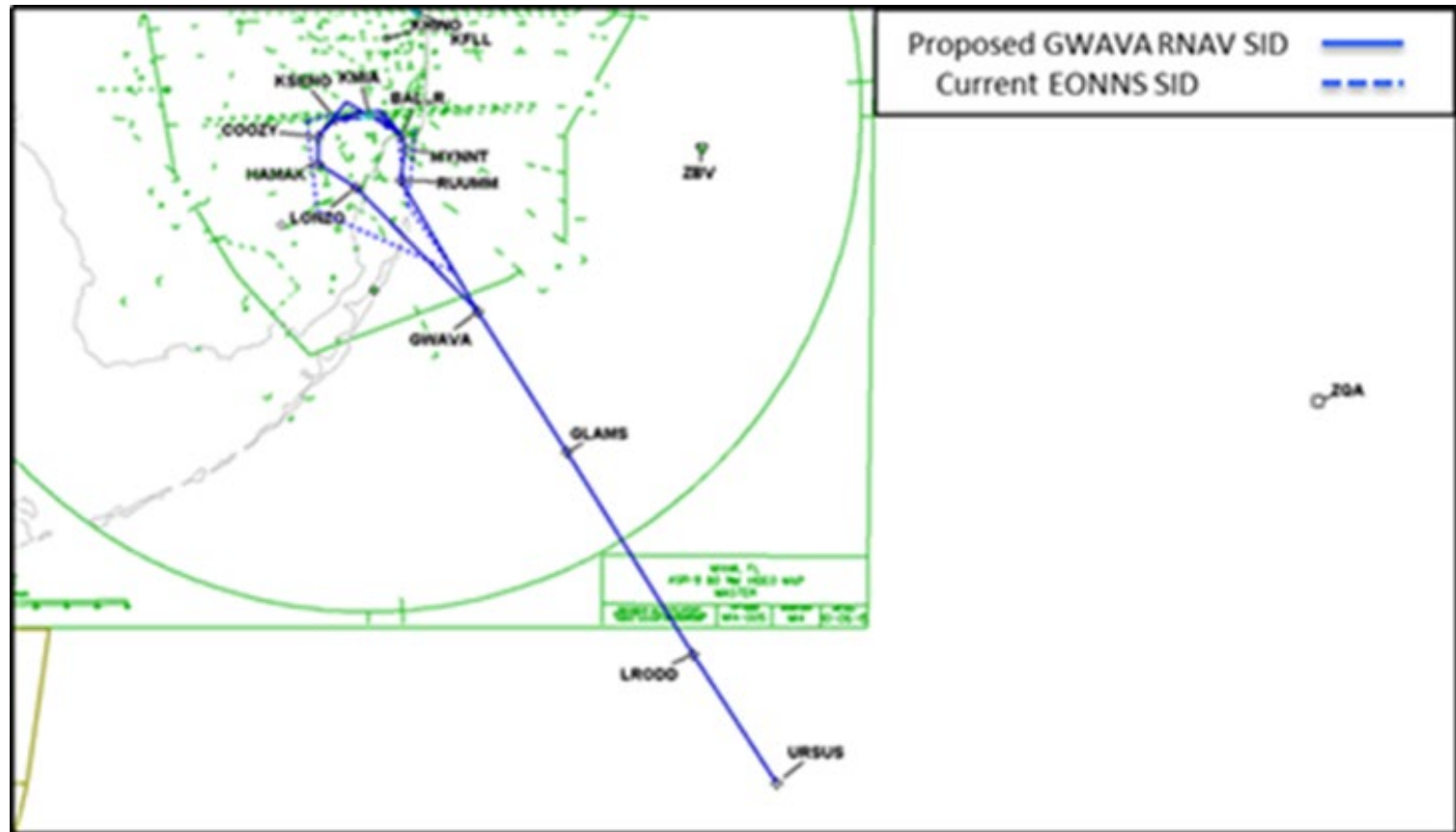

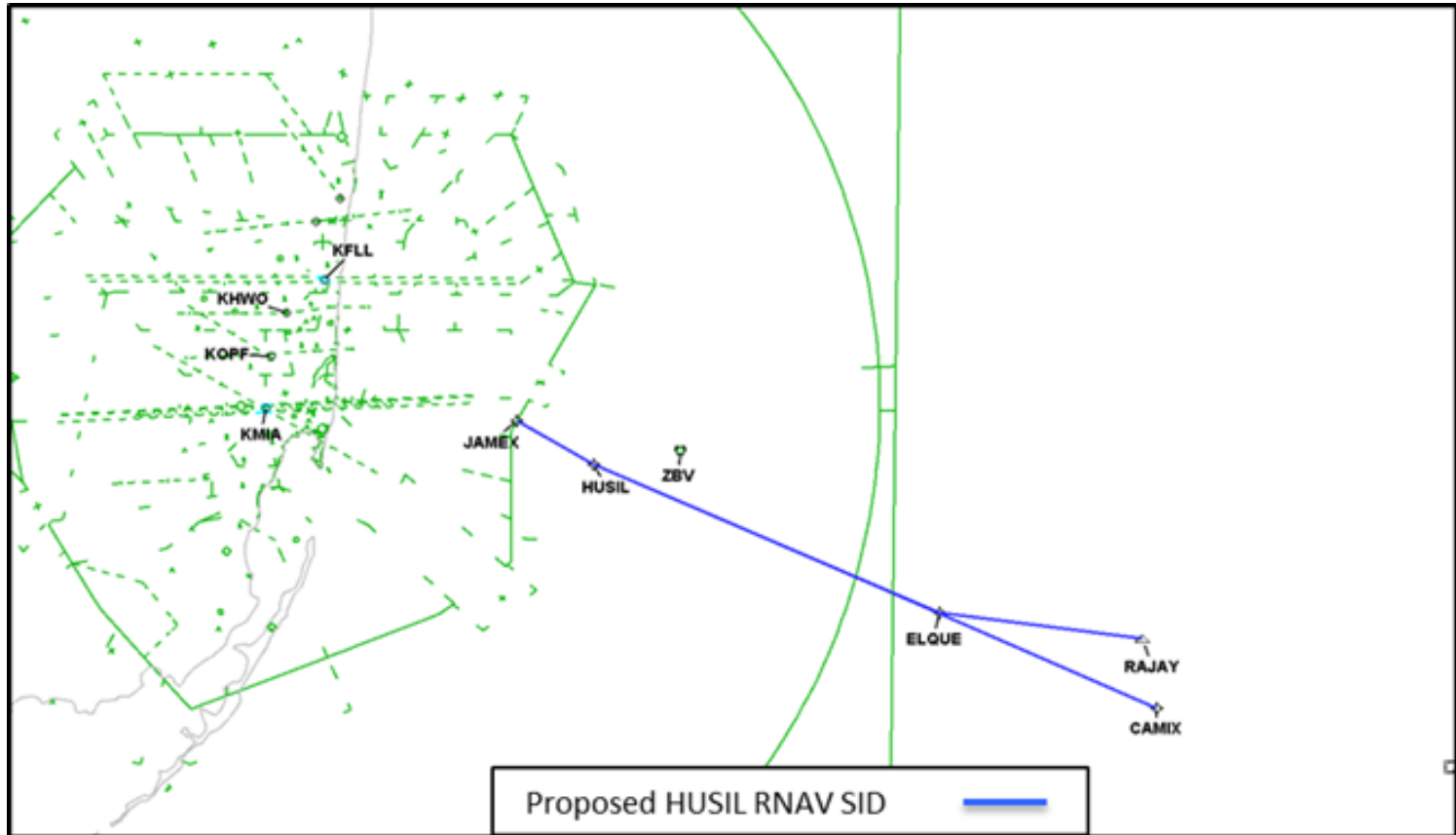

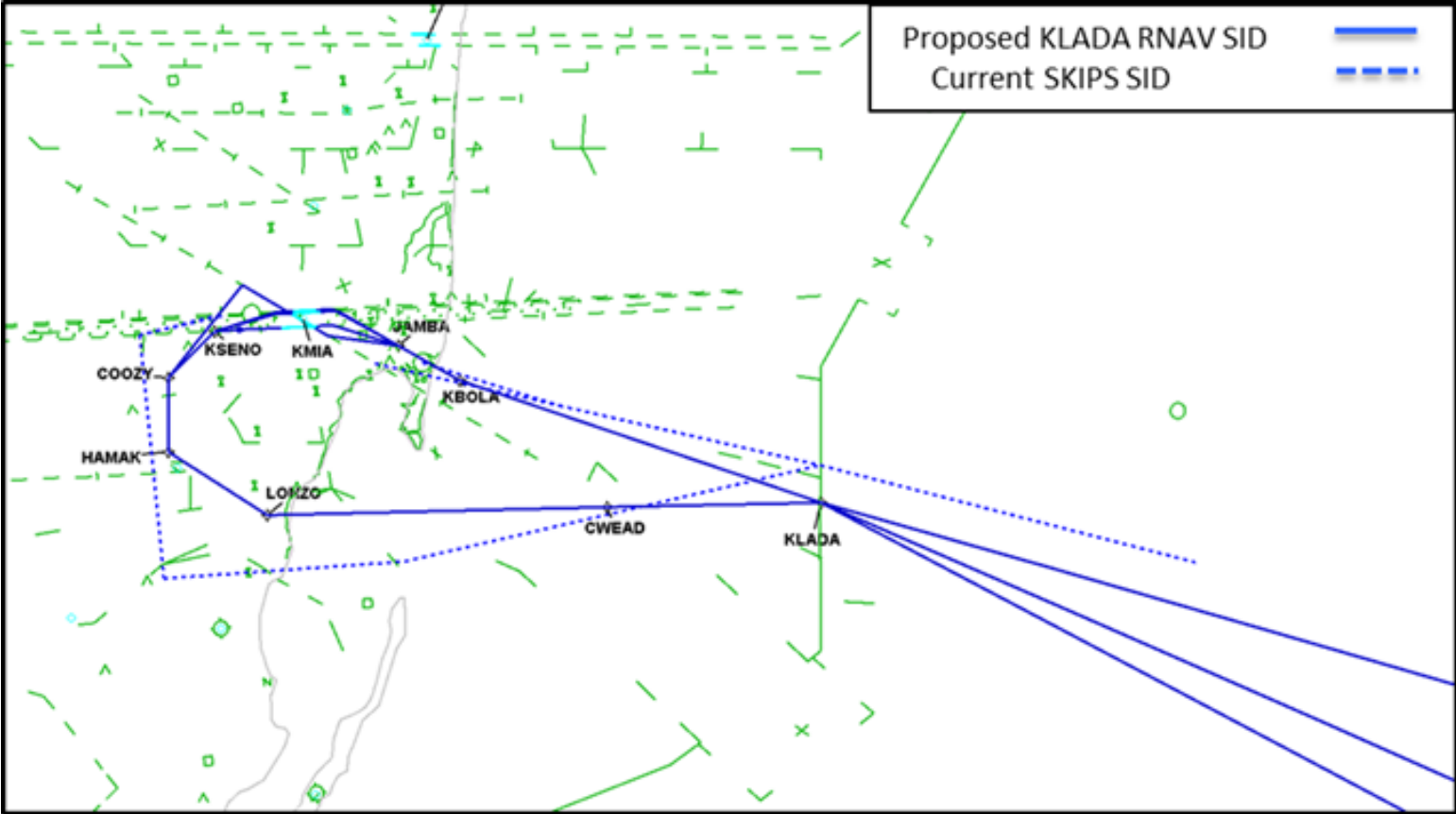

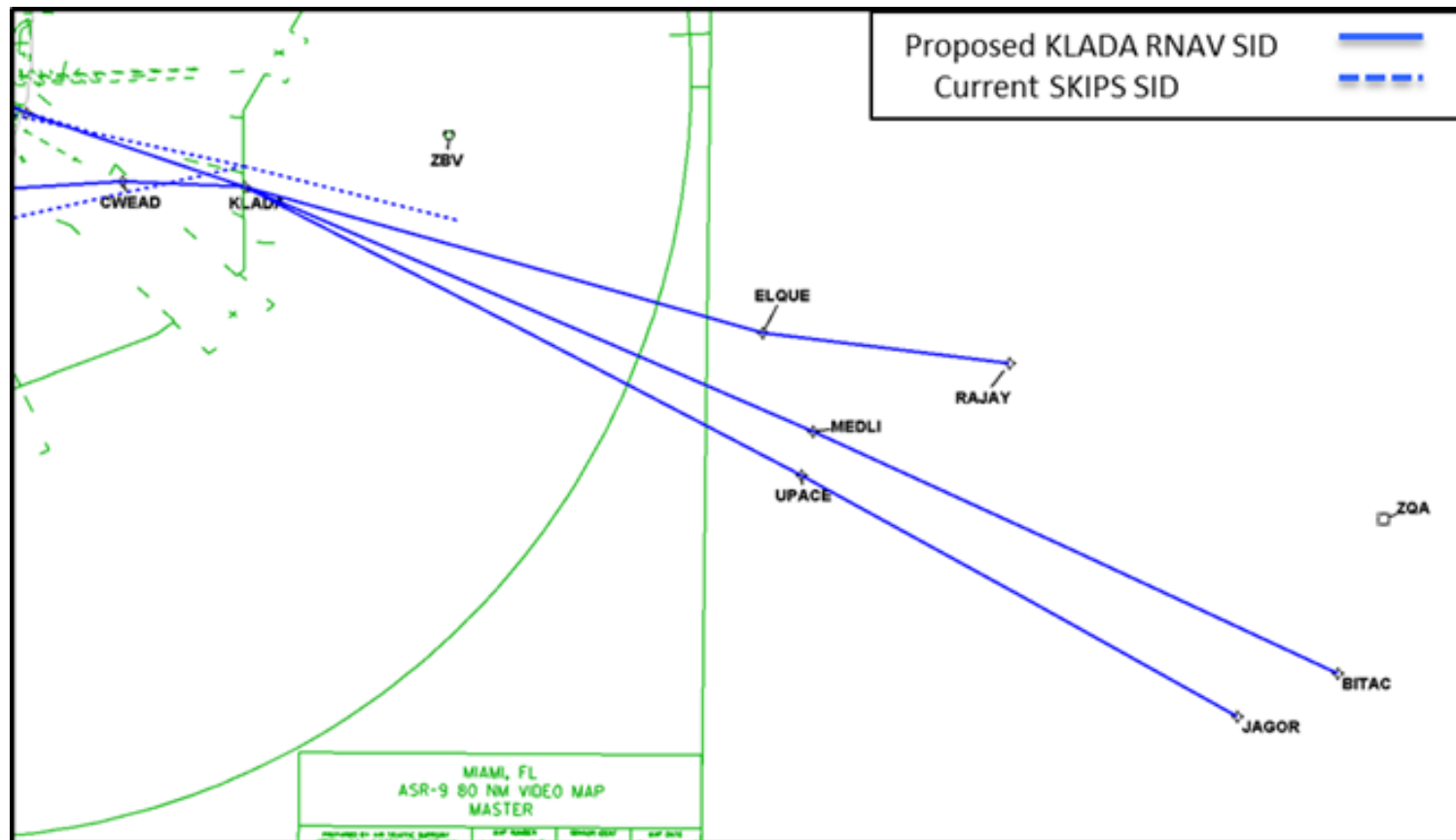

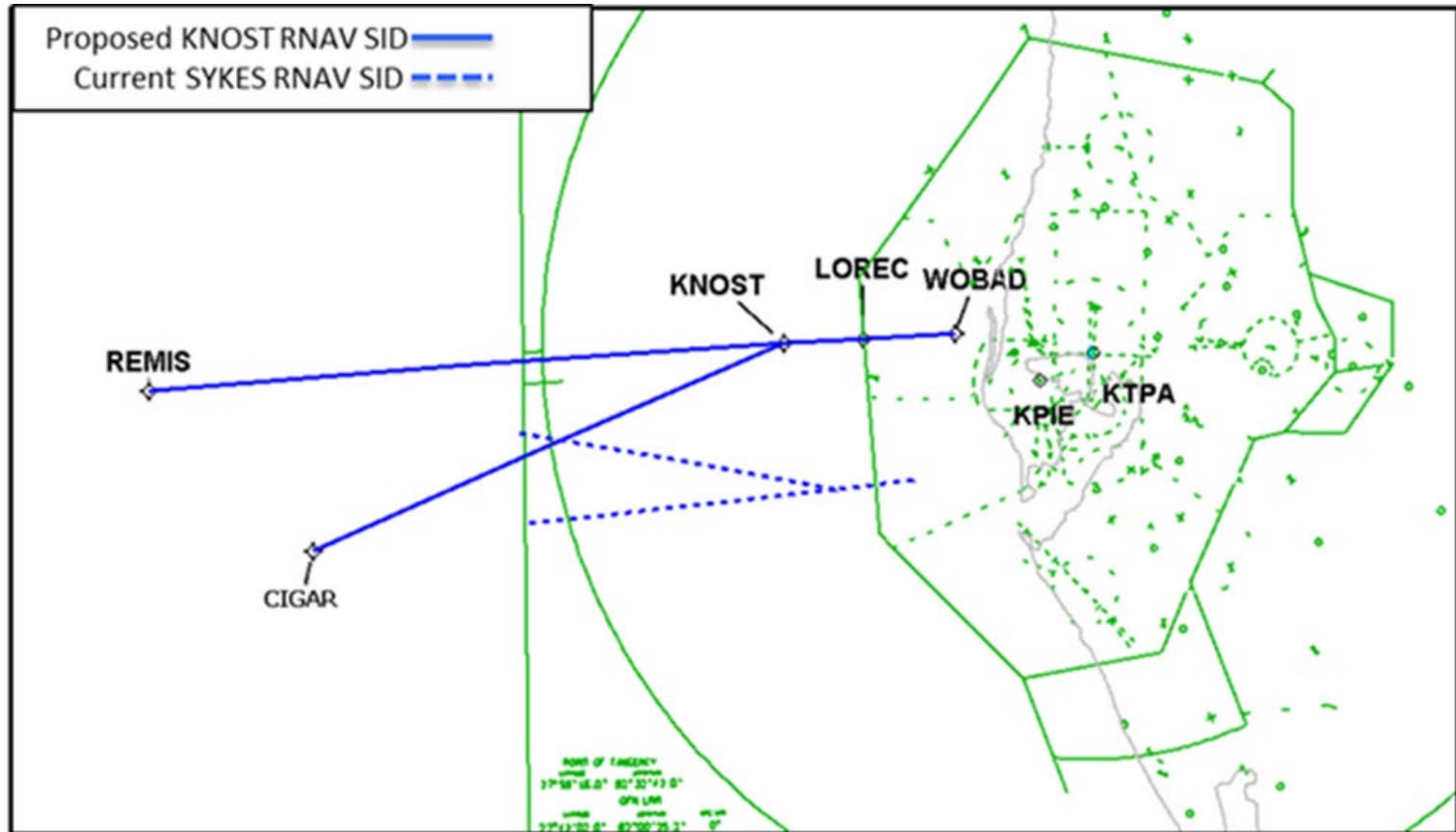

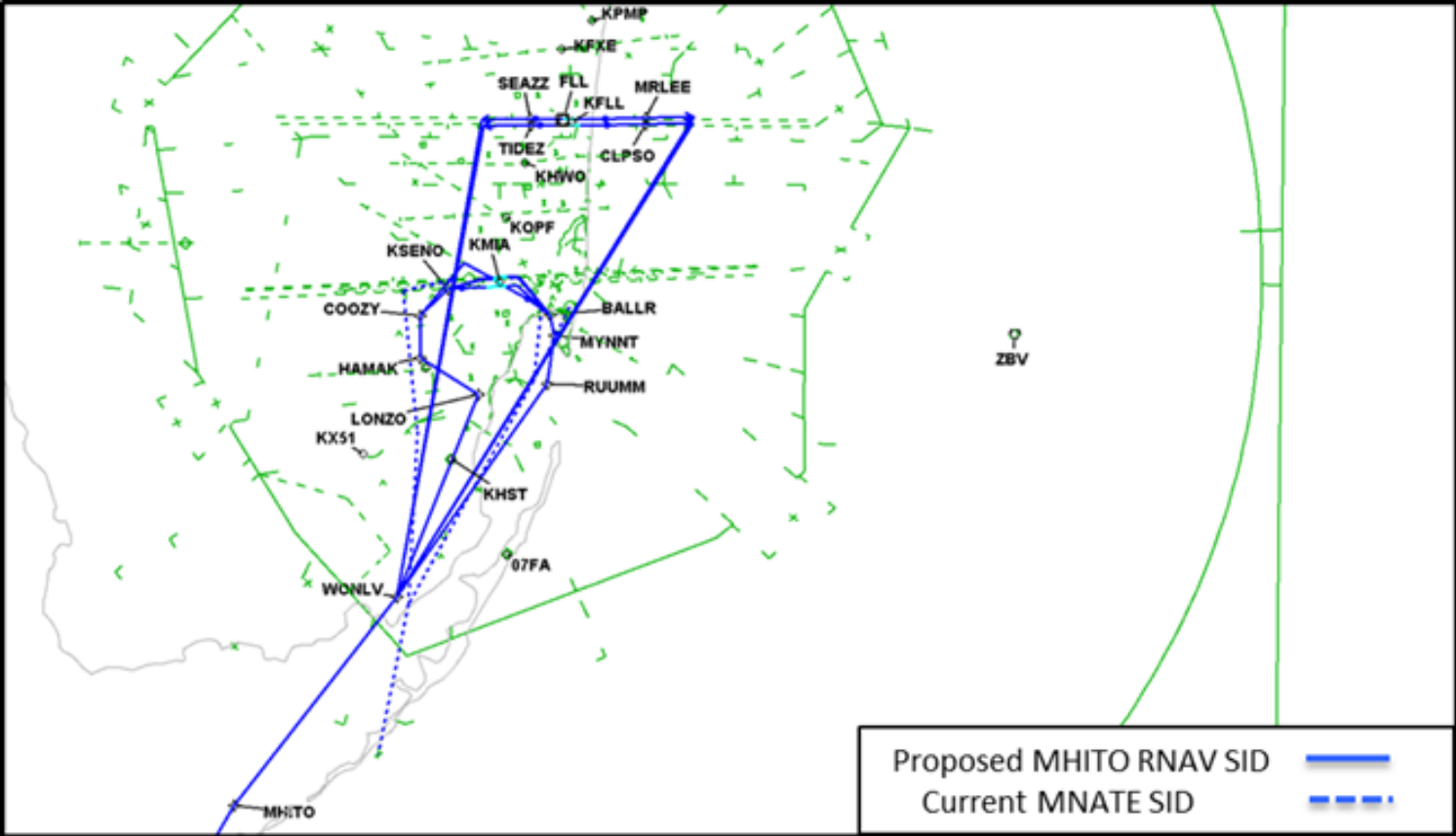

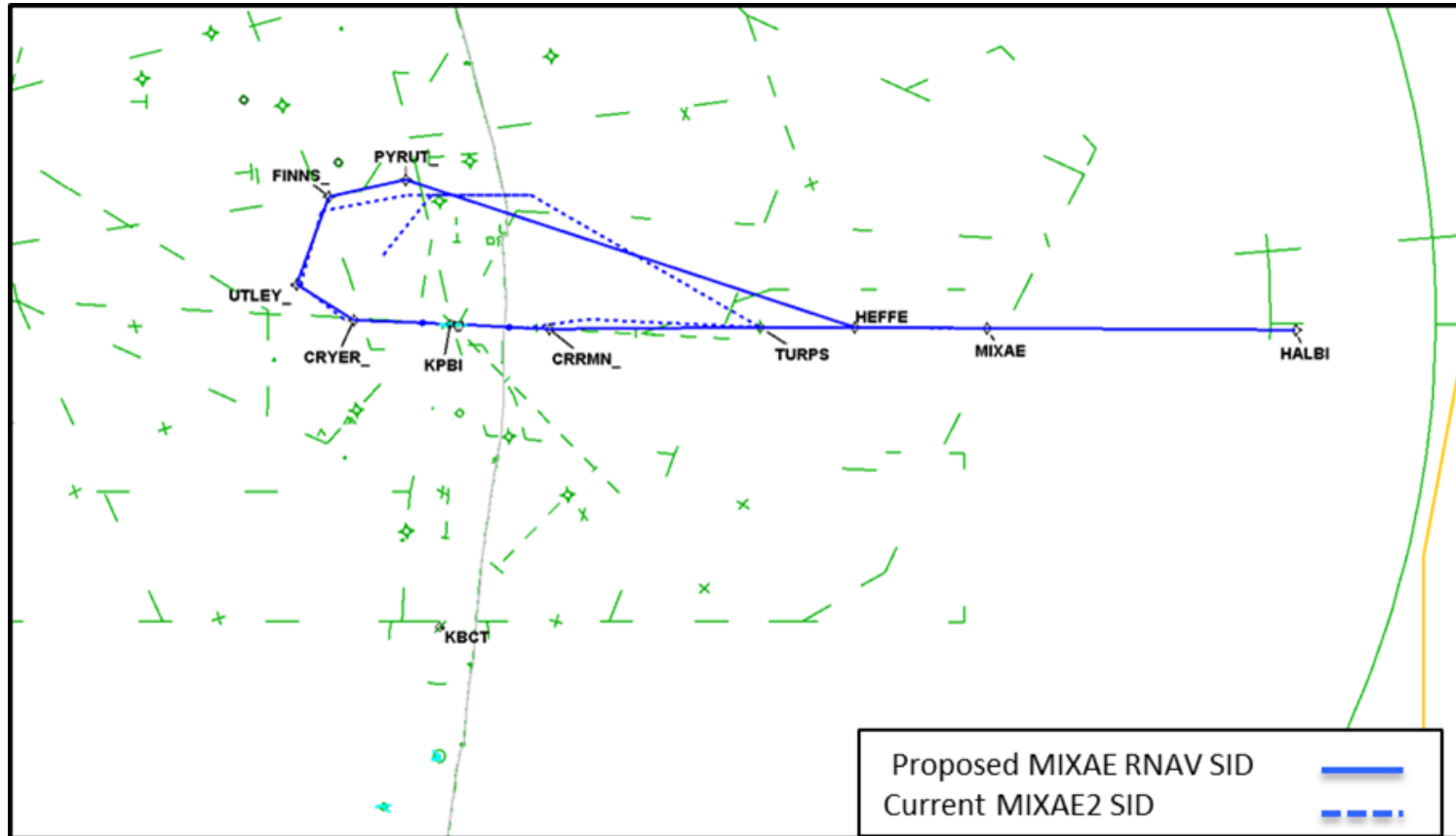

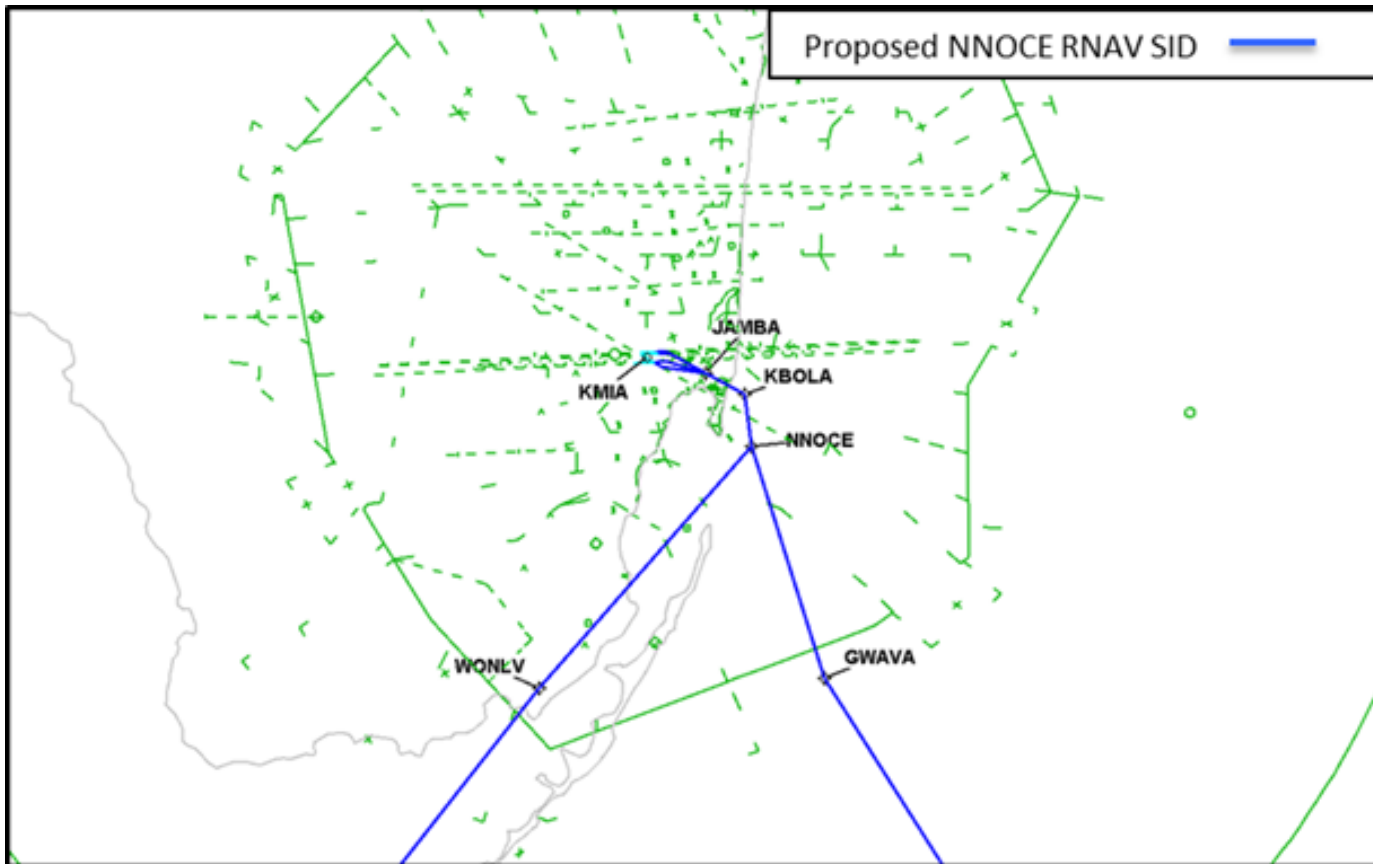

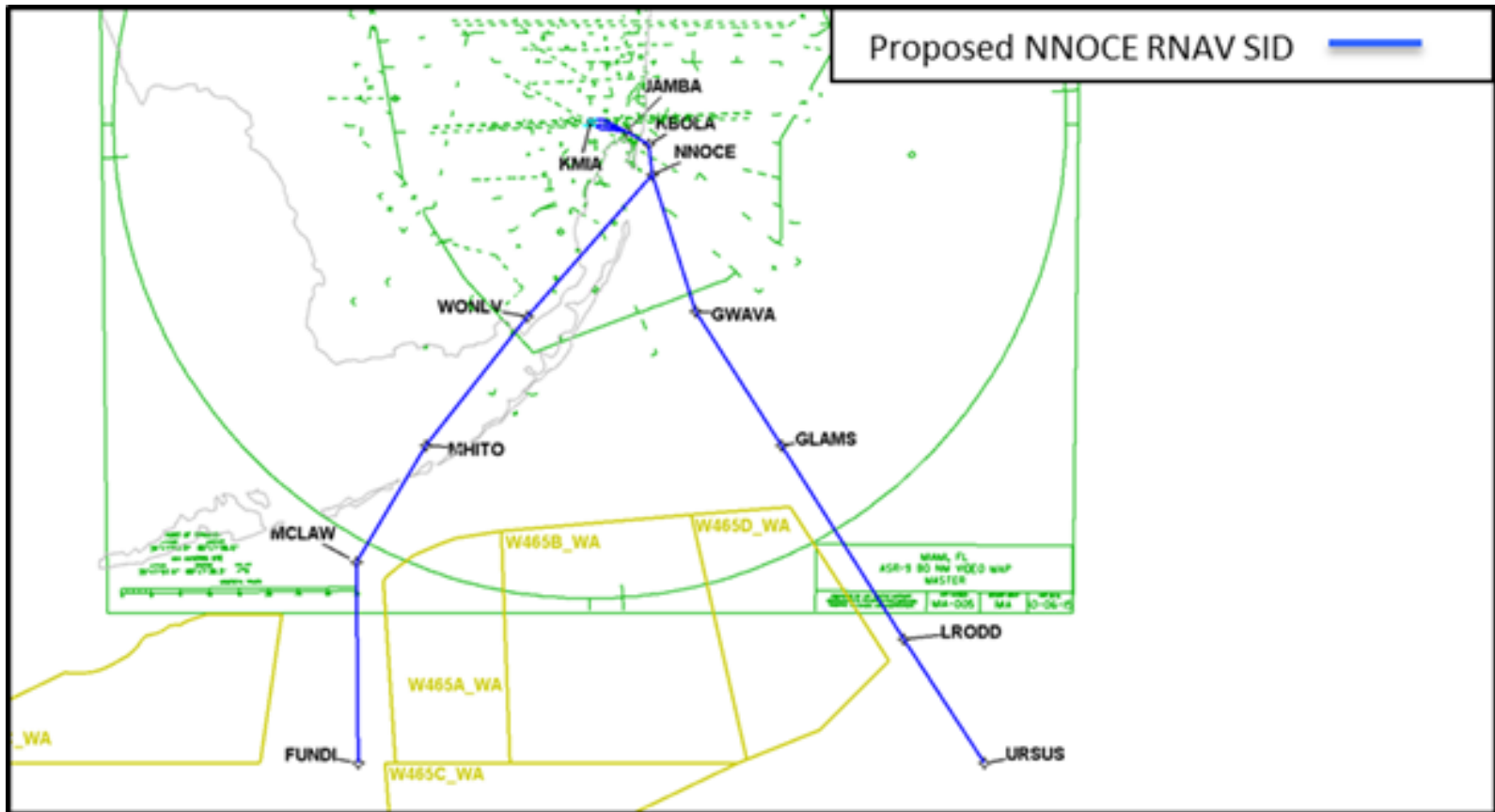

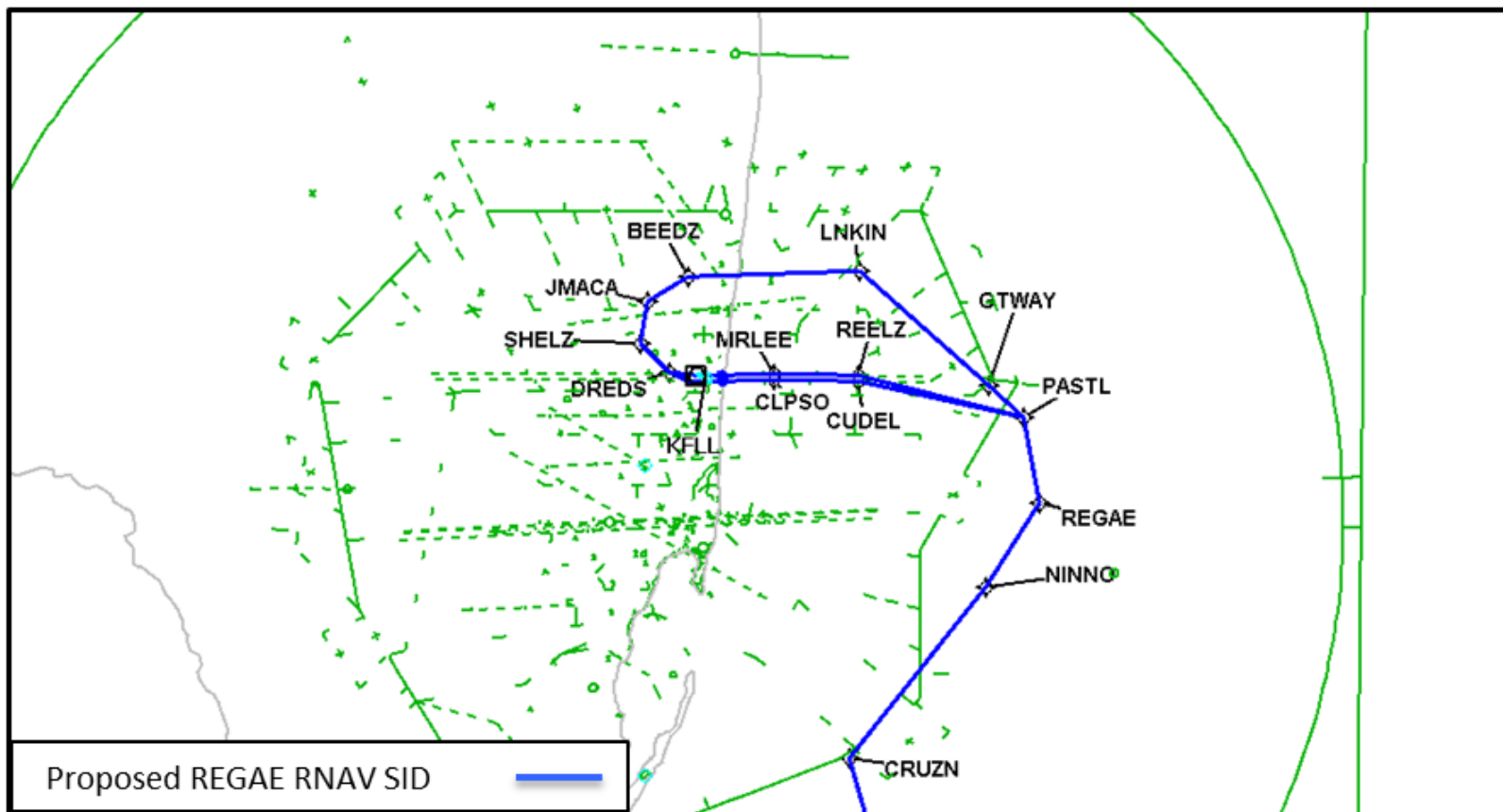
NNOCE RNAV SID Terminal View (Serves MIA, 11 P.M. TO 6 A.M. LCL)



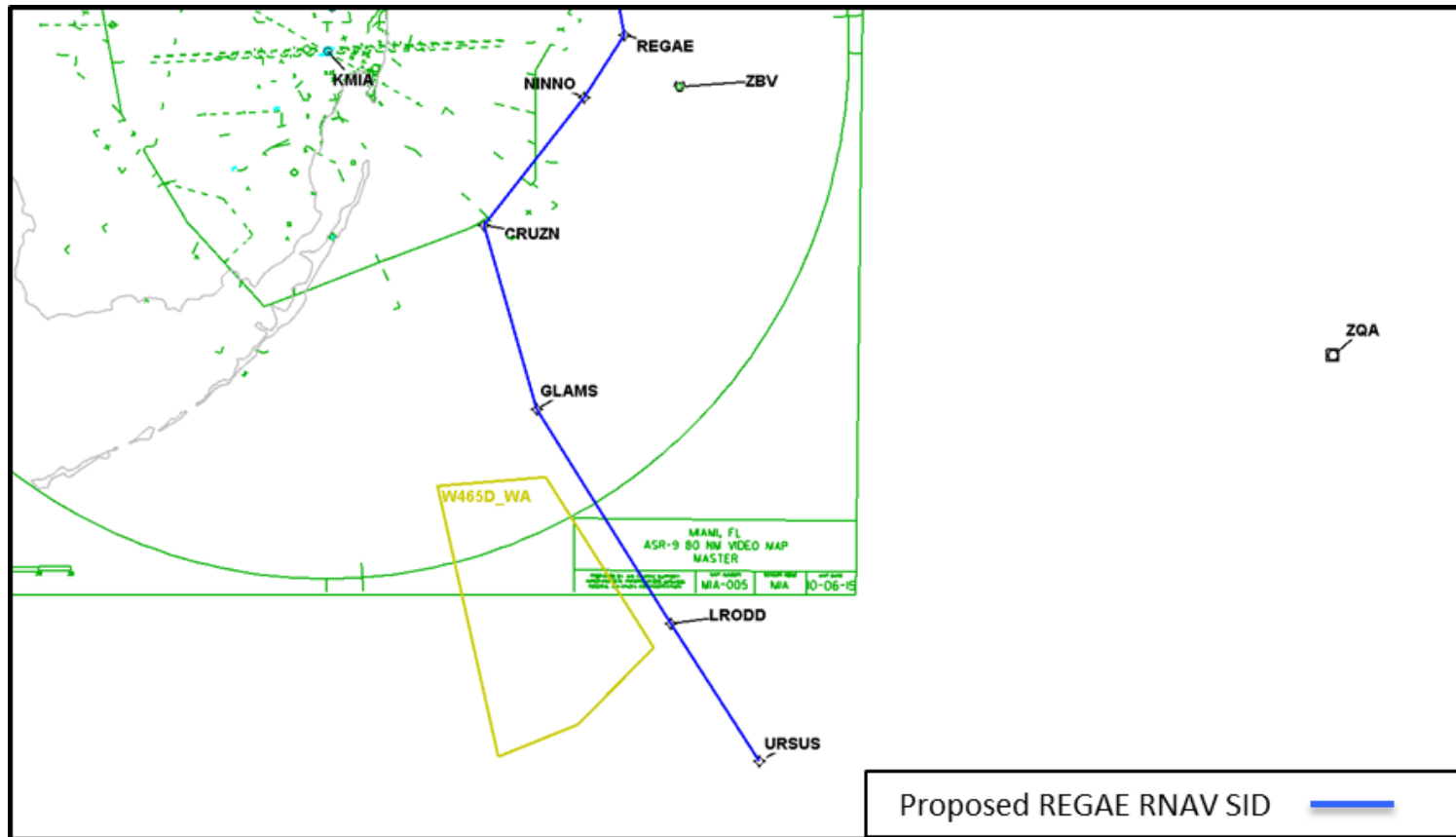
NNOCE RNAV SID Enroute View (Serves MIA, 11 P.M. TO 6 A.M.)



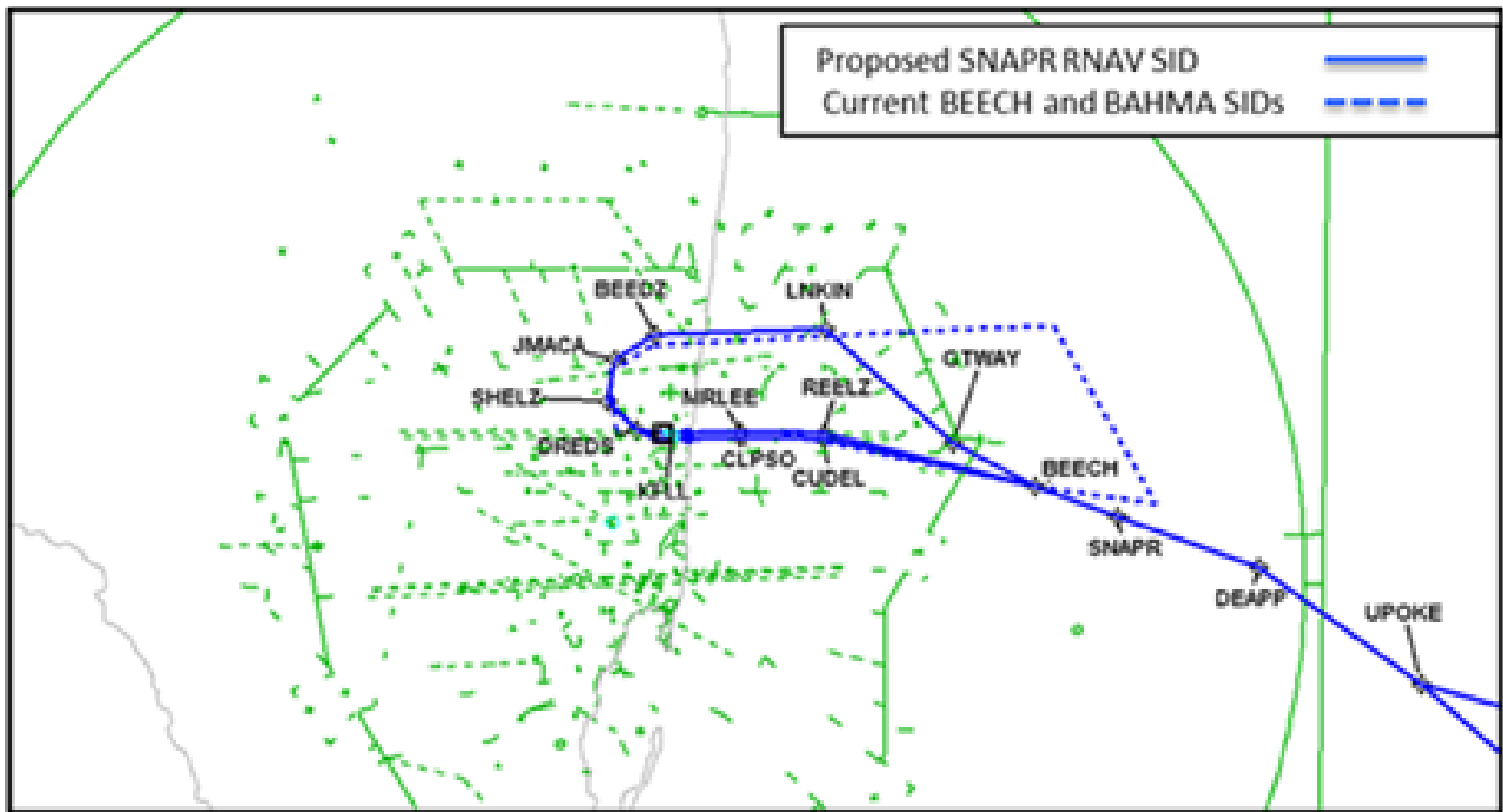

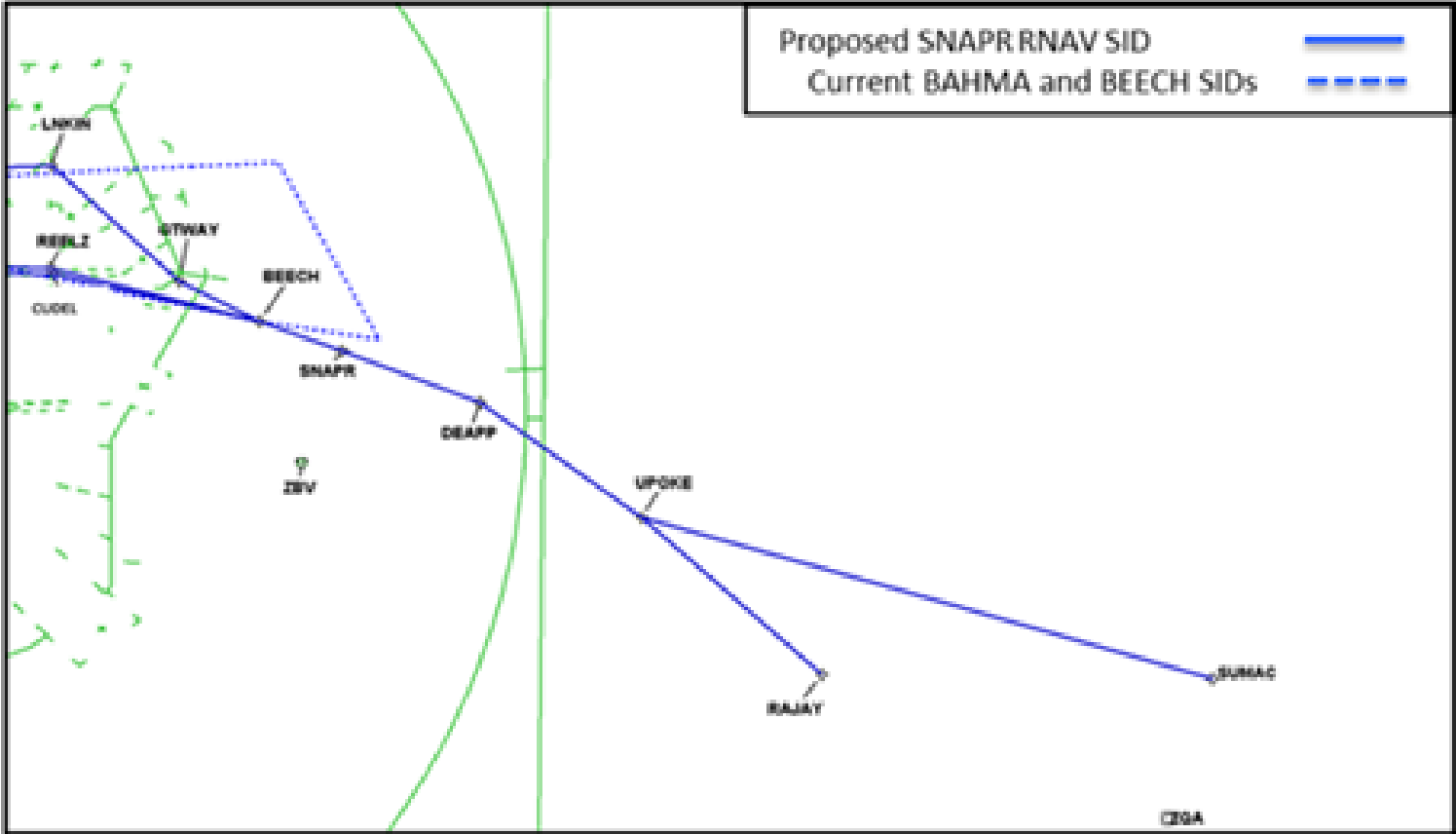

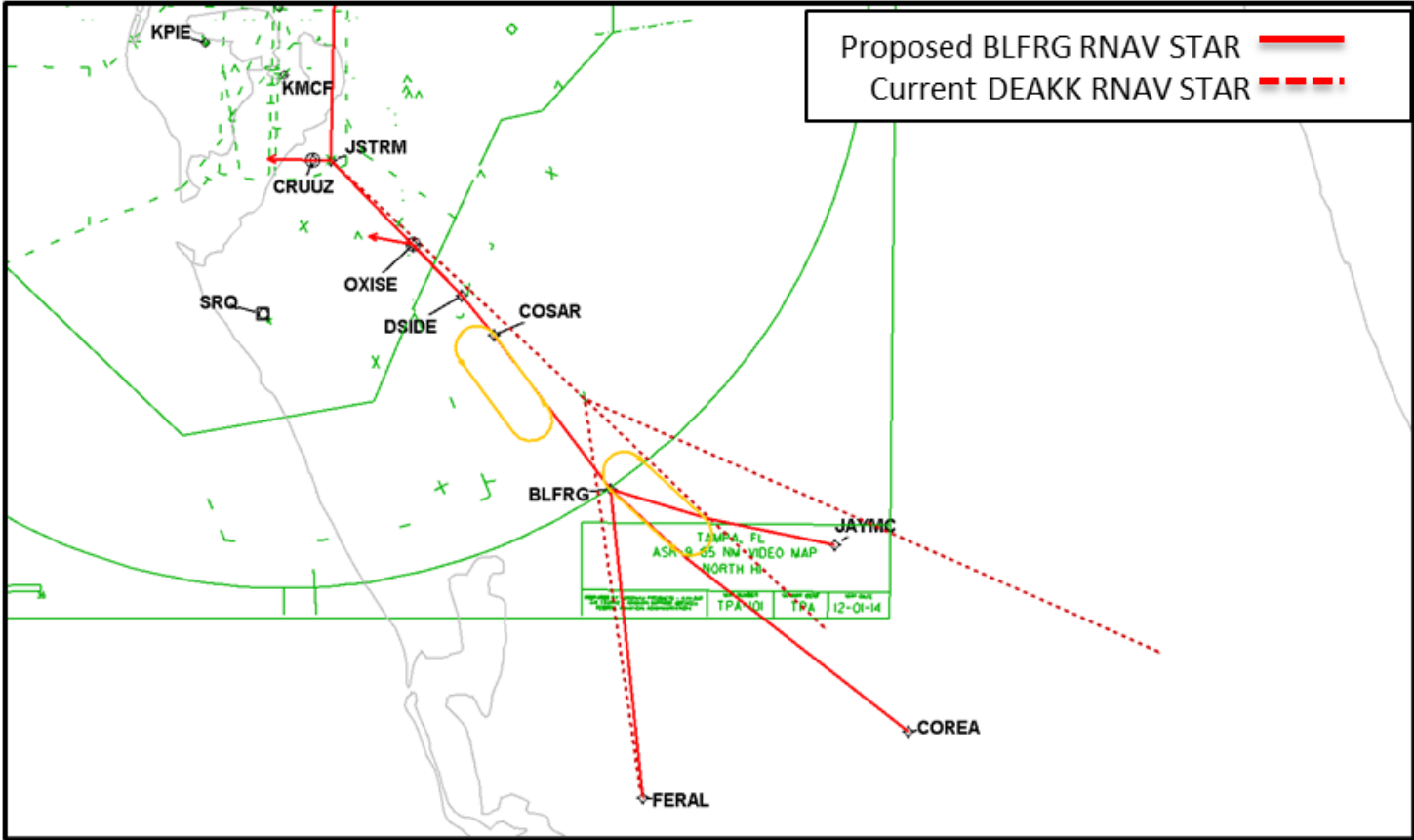
BHHIA RNAV STAR (Serves FLL, FXE, OPF, PMP) Enroute View



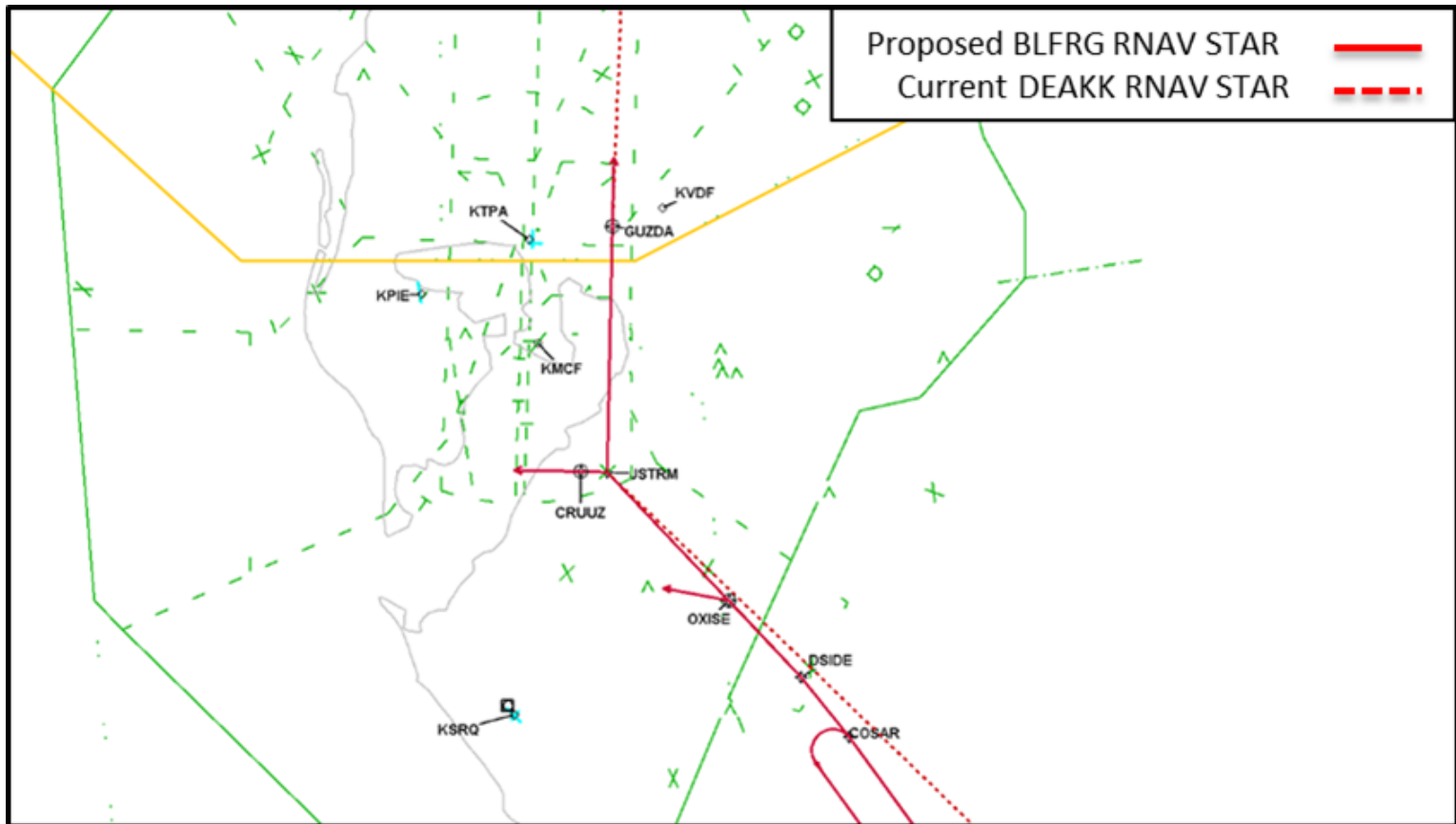

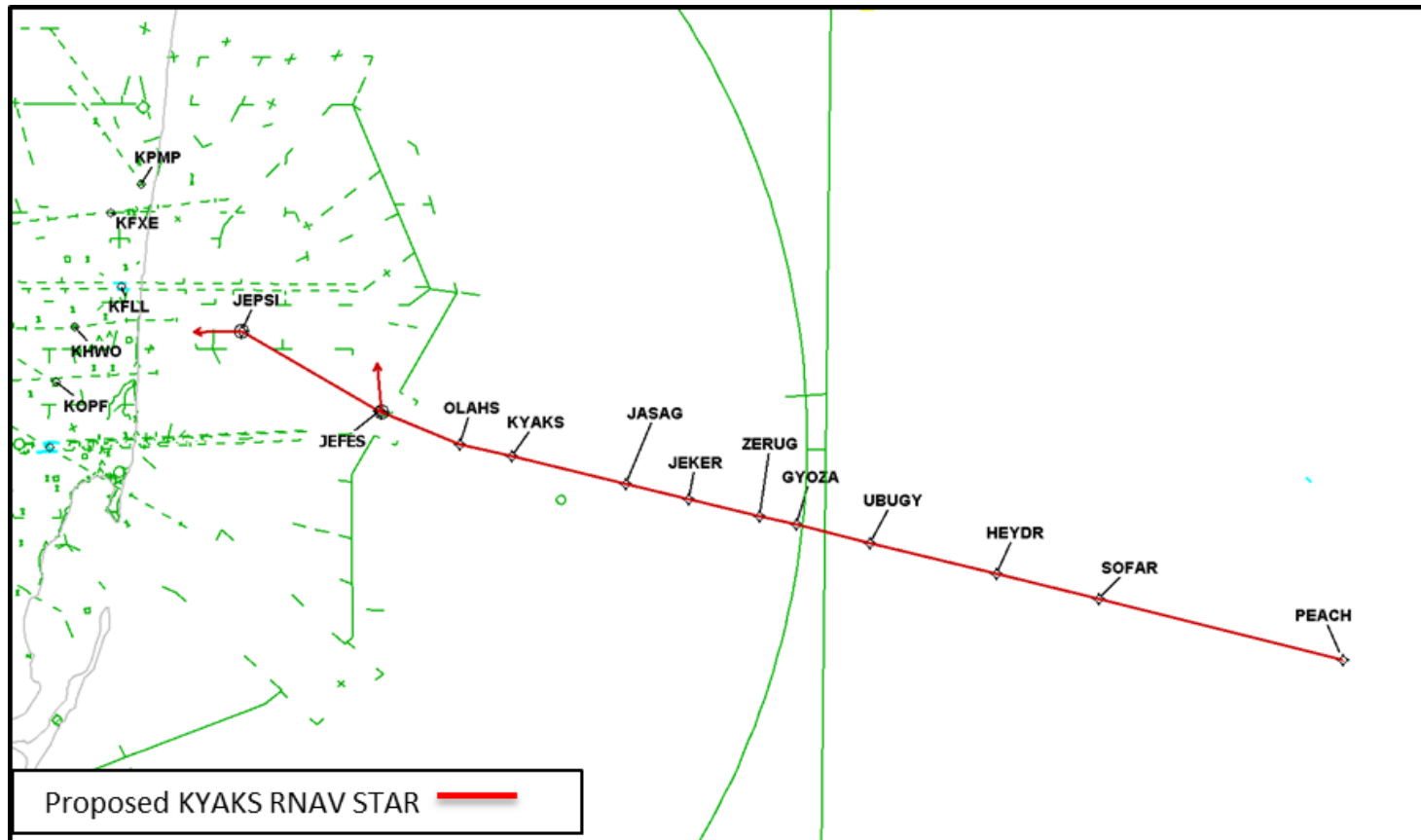
BLFRG RNAV STAR (Serves TPA, PIE, MCF, VDF) Enroute View



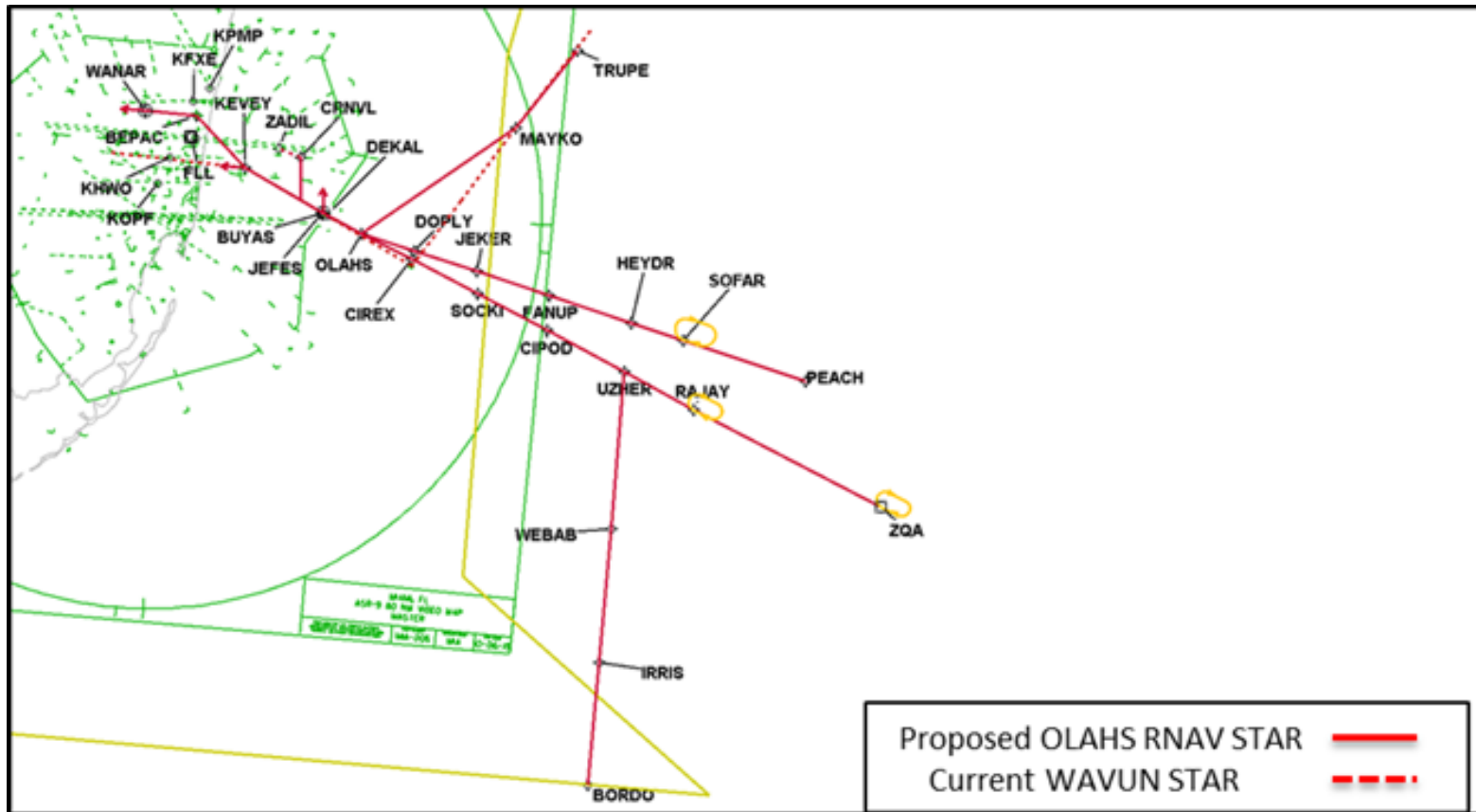

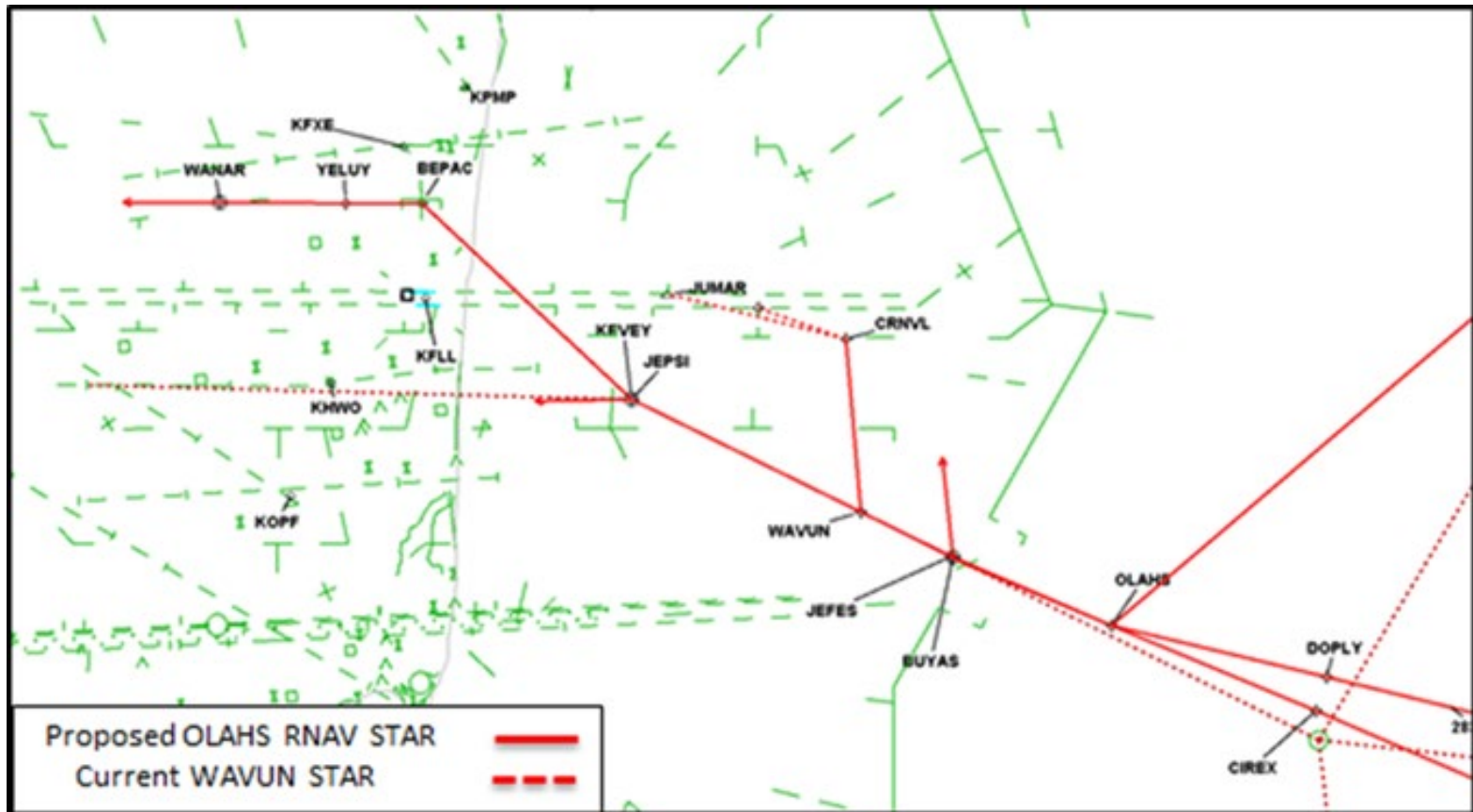

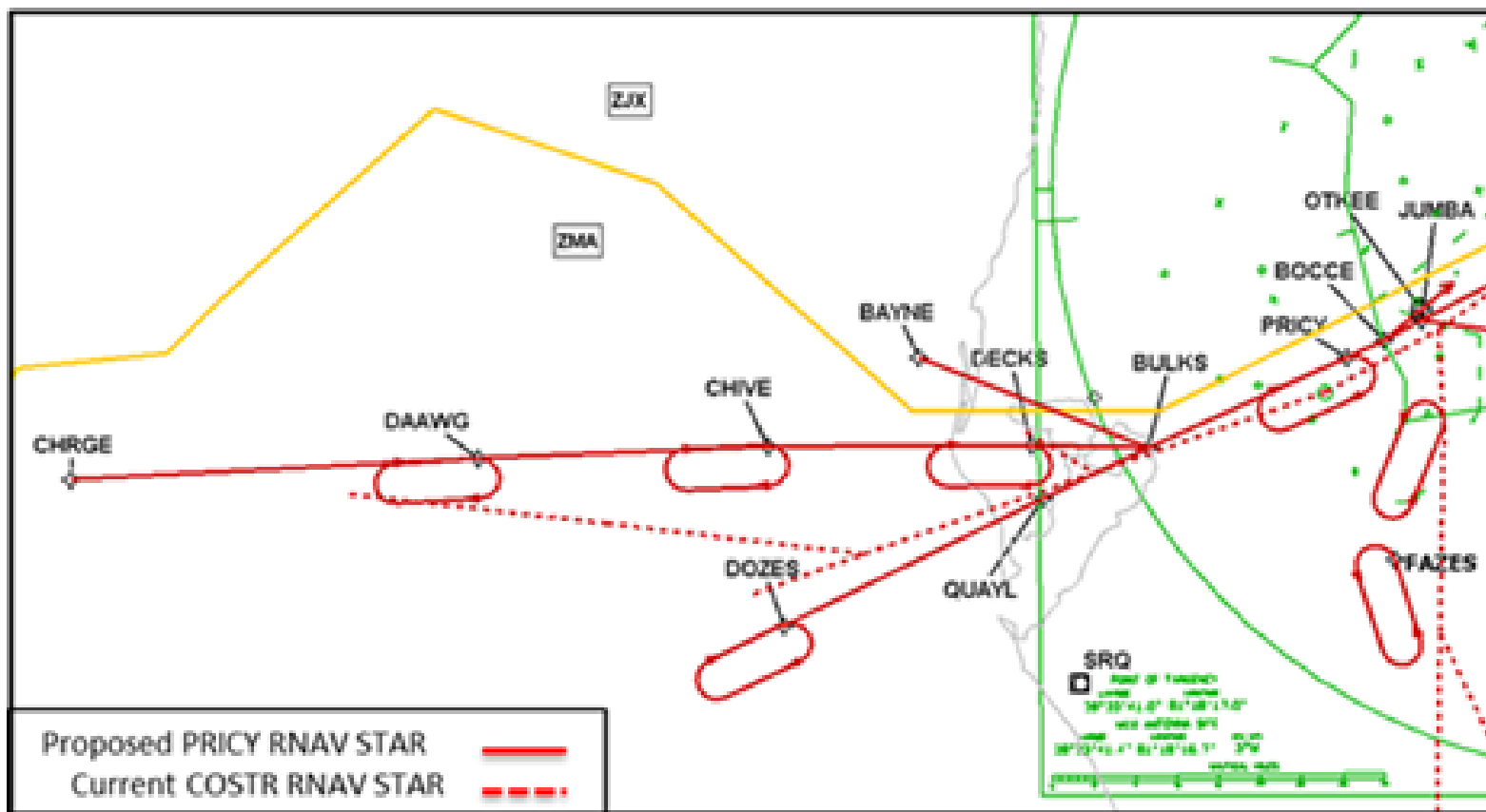

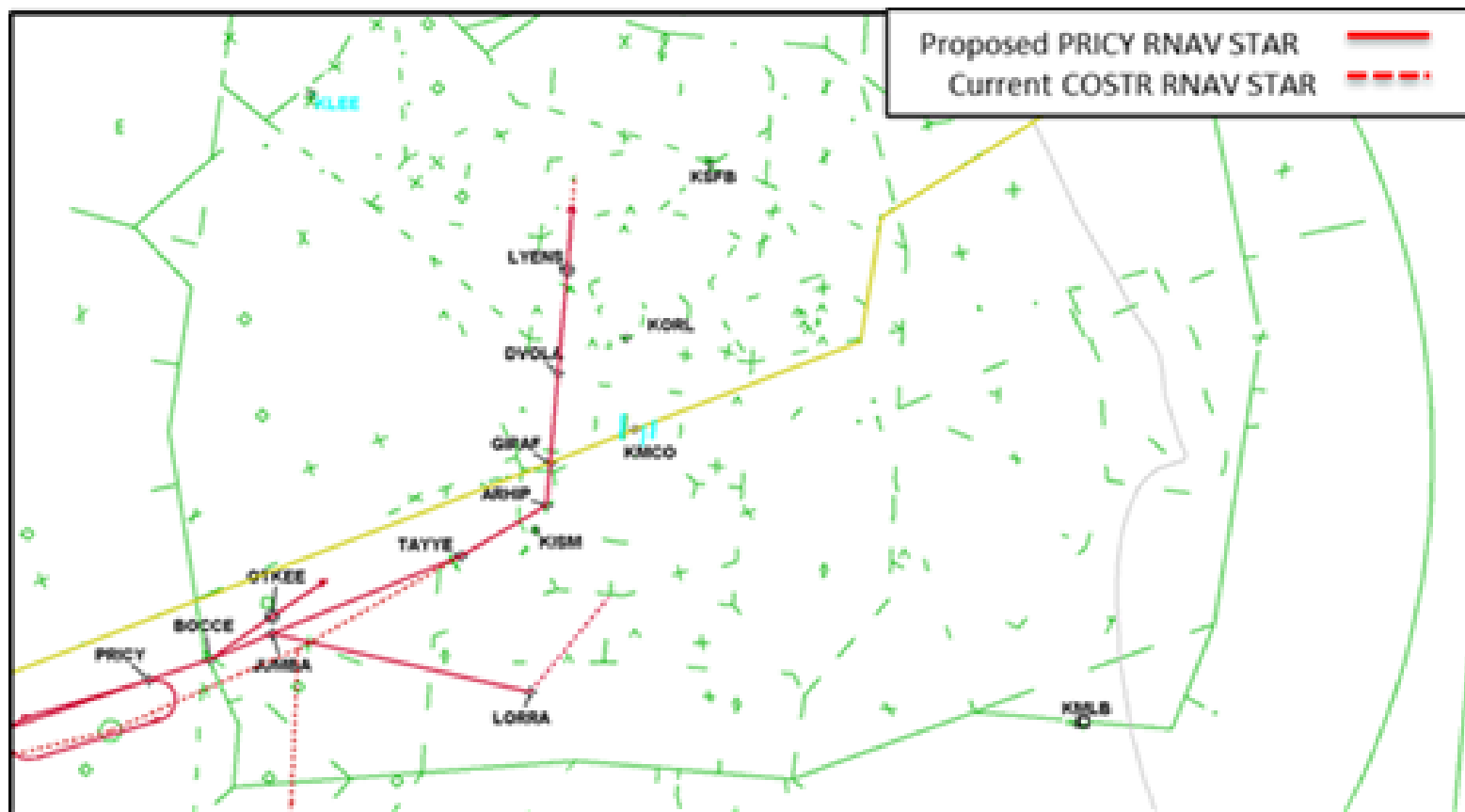

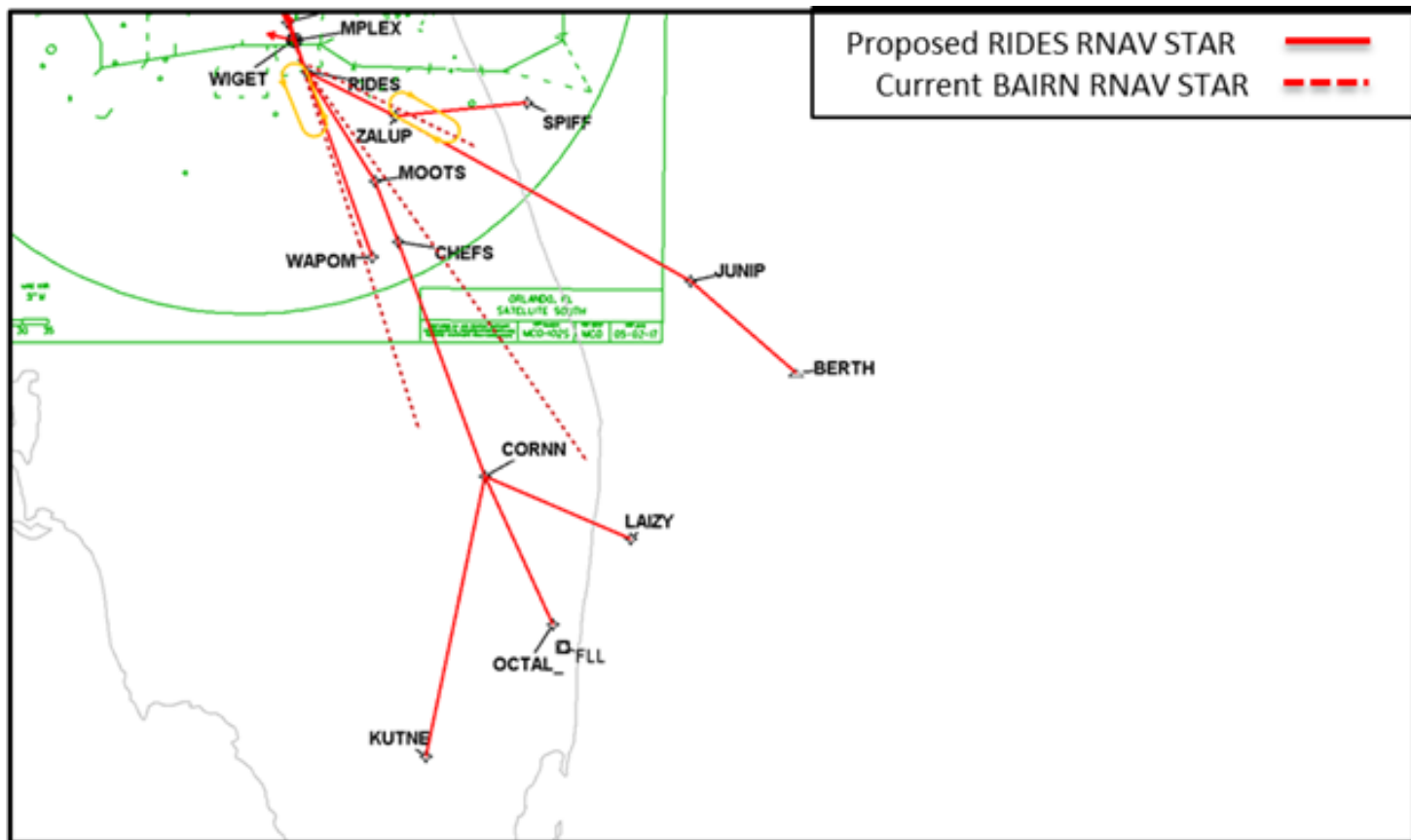

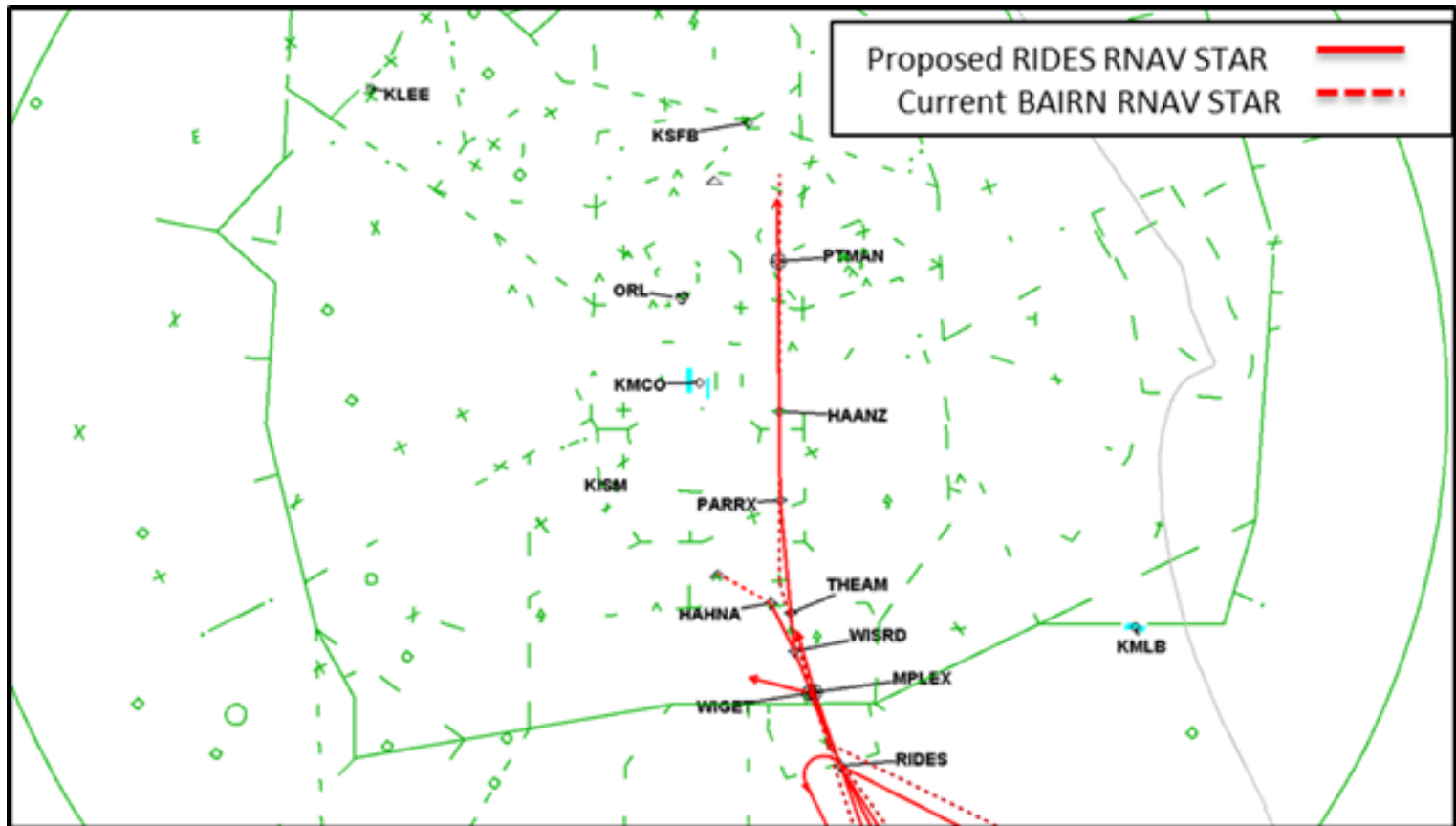

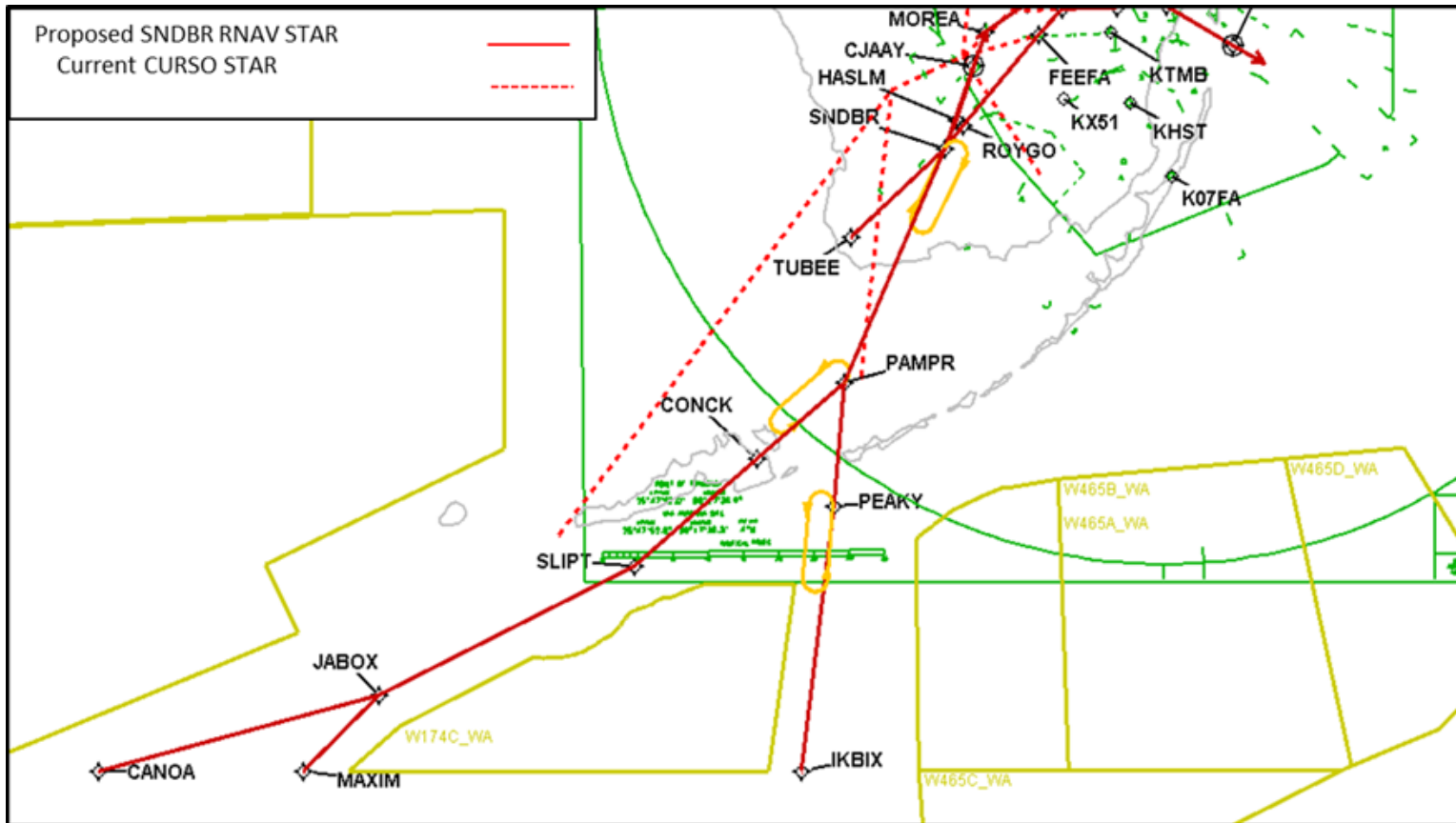

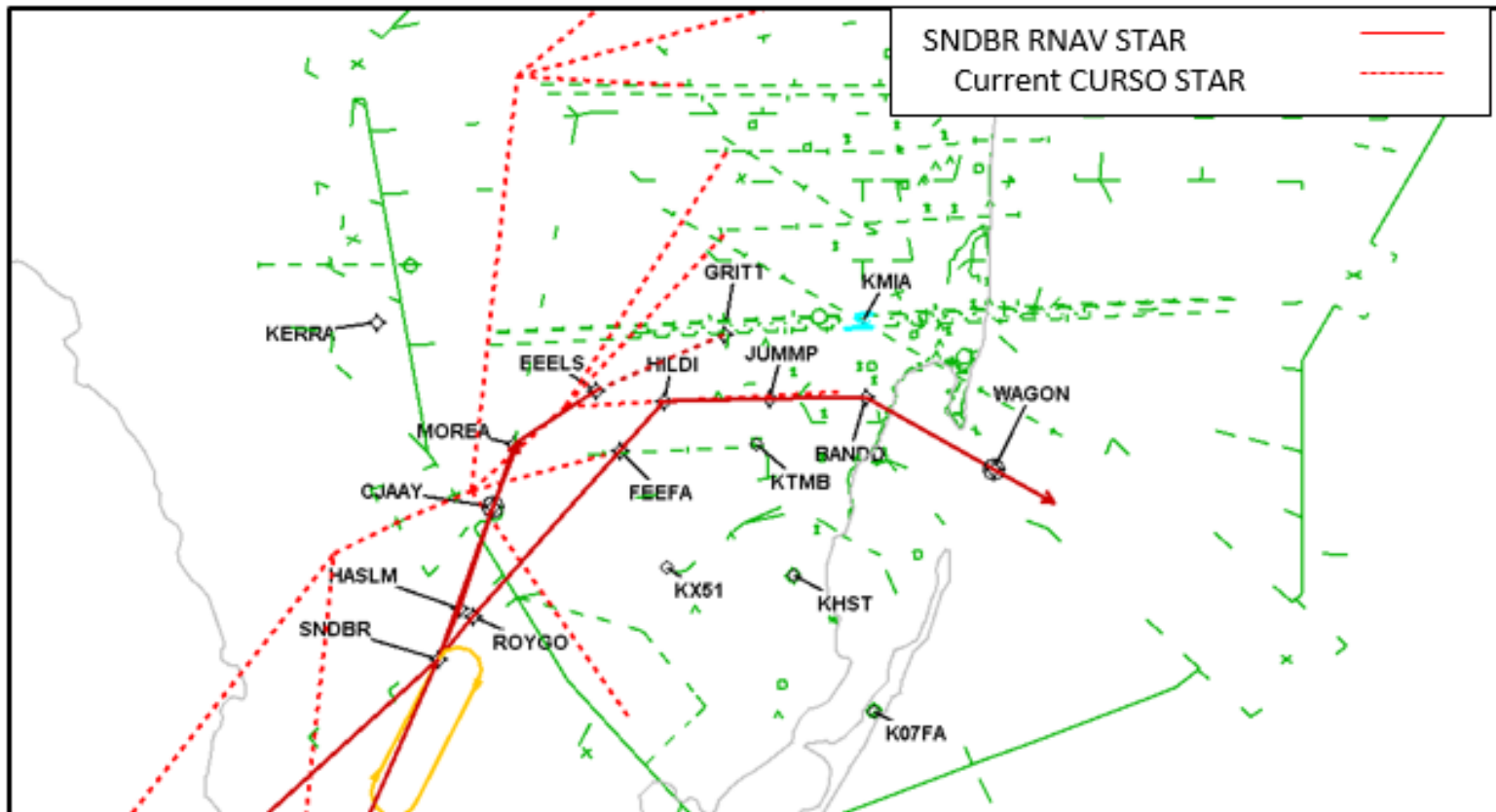

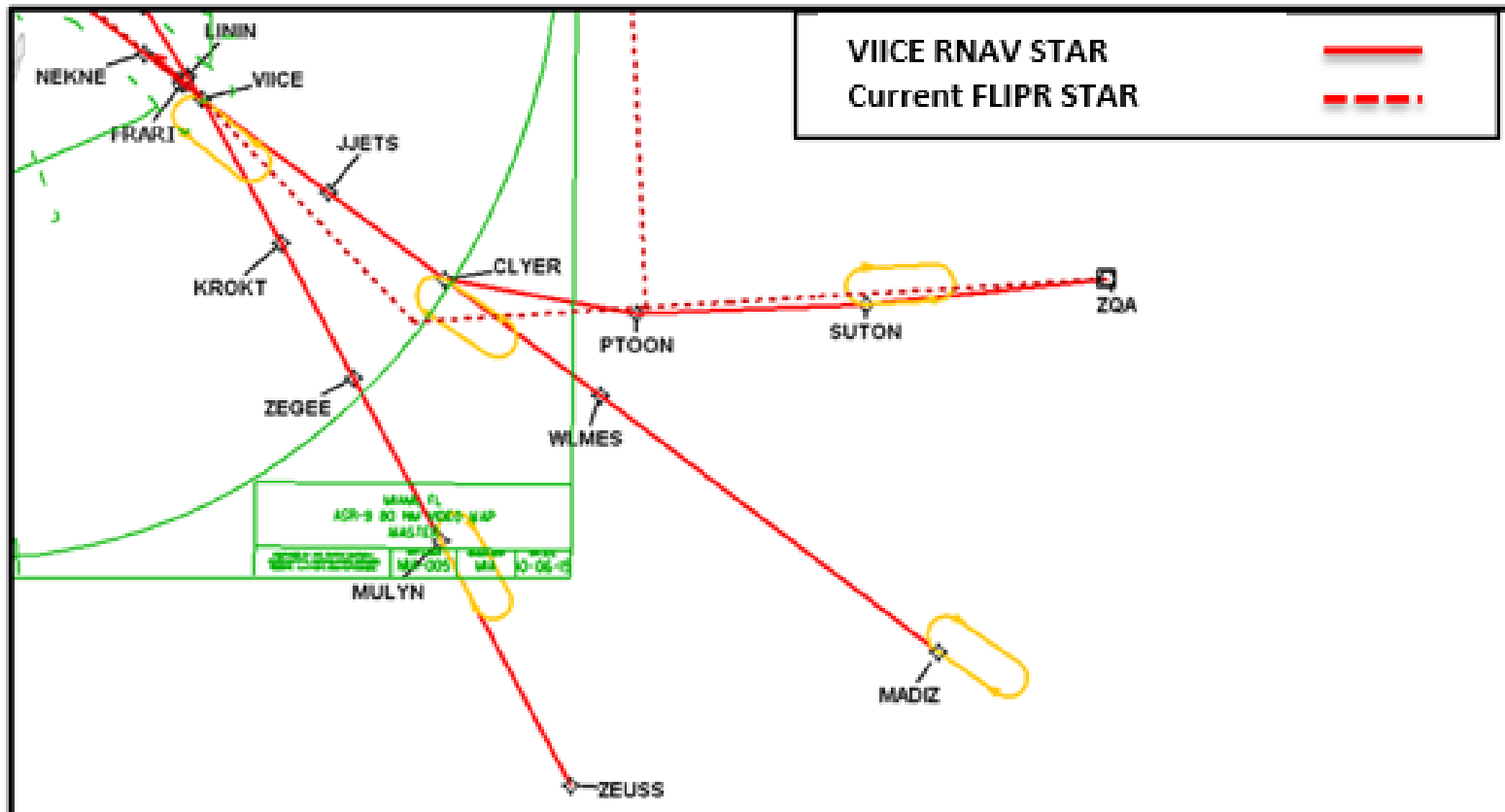
