Dear Sir/Madam,

The implementation and development of SSPs in each State is one of the global goals set out in the *Global Aviation Safety Plan* (GASP) as part of risk management, in the North America, Central America and Caribbean Regional Aviation Safety Plan (NACC RASP) and in our assistance through the NACC Systemic Assistance Programme (SAP) as a critical element of Phase V. Therefore, I am pleased to inform you that the activities of the SSP Group will resume, which were in pause since the last SSP teleconference in August 2020.

In this sense, I wish to invite your Administration and, in particular, your State Safety Programme (SSP) Points of Contact (PoCs), to participate in the Second State Safety Programme (SSP) Meeting for the NAM/CAR Regions (NAM/CAR/SSP/2) to be convened on line on **4 November 2021**, from 10:00 AM to 1:30 PM hours CST (UTC - 6).

In this meeting, additional to the follow-up to the actions agreed in 2020, information will be provided on the Protocol Questions (PQ) of the State Safety Programme Implementation Assessment (SSPIA) and the planning of the gap analysis evaluations of the NACC States. Among other critical subjects, the Meeting will also review and update the SSPs Terms of Reference (ToRs). The participation of Canada as a SAP "Champion State" and other States will be crucial for the follow-up of activities to assist the implementation of the SSP.

SSP PoCs of States and Territories of the ICAO NAM/CAR Regions are expected to attend. The working languages of the Meeting will be English and Spanish, and simultaneous interpretation will be provided if sufficient participants of both languages provide timely registration. The Provisional Agenda is shown in **Attachment A**.

It is important to note that all participants need to have a Zoom account as all sessions scheduled by ICAO are only for authenticated users. Working papers received in this office <u>after</u> that date will have to be submitted in both languages. Otherwise, they will become Information Papers. Information papers will only be issued in the language submitted. Papers received from international organizations will not be translated and will be issued only in the language submitted. The deadline to receive papers is <u>1 November 2021</u>. The deadlines for submission of documentation for translation will be strictly enforced. You are encouraged to submit documentation in both meeting languages (i.e., English and Spanish).

Under this agenda item, the Meeting will conduct a follow-up review of valid conclusions and decisions. Due to the difficulties experienced by the States during COVID-19, the plans and tasks of implementing the SSP were interrupted, therefore tICAO wishes to resume these activities and a recapitulation of them will be made based on the topics discussed during the last teleconferences of 2020.

# Agenda Item 5: Planning the evaluation of the gap analysis in the States of the CAR Region according to their progress and Effective Implementation (EI)

States are expected to report on the status of progress in these analyses.
