GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Event Venue and Dates

1.1 The ICAO NACC/DCA/10 meeting will be hosted by the French West Indies Civil Aviation Authority and will be held at La Batelière hotel in Schoelcher, Martinique. The working language of the event will be English and Spanish with simultaneous interpretation. Participants are to arrive at the airport of Fort-de-France (FDF), Martinique.

Rates (Euro currency)

5.3 Note: These rates will apply for reservations made before or by **28 May 2022**. Although no change of dates of the meeting are expected, in case the meeting is postponed for local sanitary reasons, your deposit will be entirely refunded by the hotel until 3 June 2022.

6. Temperature

6.1 In December, the average temperature in Martinique is between 25°C (77°F) and 34°C (93.2°F); humidity is around 79%.

7. Organized day trips for spouses

7.1 Numerous activities will soon be proposed by the host State for the participants' partners/spouses, they will be included in the notice's coming update.

8. Currency and Money exchange

8.1 The Martinican currency is the Euro. After your arrival, currency can be exchanged at the airport or in specific local banks. The island also has many ATM cash machines that accept Visa and Mastercard cards.

8.2 The US dollar is accepted in some establishments as well as the travellers cheques. International Credit cards as American Express (AMEX), MasterCard and Visa are accepted almost everywhere (shopping malls, hotels, restaurants...). Foreign or French Metropolitan cheques are not generally accepted.

9. Tax and Tip

9.1 Tax is included in services and prices. Tips are normally included in services.

10. Local Transportation

10.1 Taxis are available at the airport and at the hotel. The average taxi fare is around 35 euros. Car rentals are available at the airport as well as at the hotel (specify if you want an automatic car).

12. Commercial Working Hours

12.1 Commercial working hours in the city are approximately from 08:30 to 4:00 pm. Banks are open from Monday to Friday 08:30 to 4 pm. Major malls & shopping centres opening hours are from 10:00 to 7.00 pm or later.

13.1 To be verified at French embassies and consulates for each State.

15. Water, electricity

- Tap water is safe to drink unless specified differently.
- The electrical current is 220 volts. Mind to bring an adapter.

16.1 Martinique disposes of several telephone providers (Orange, Digicel, SFR,..). Free Wifi at venue hotel and airport.
