



#### Why is it important that we carry out a CAP after a Self Assessment

- The self-assessment is an updated review of the requirements established by ICAQ
- Taking into account the time elapsed since the last full audit, it may no longer be necessary to update existing CAPS and priority should be given to what is found in the self-assessment.

• The necessary coordination will be carried out, as applicable, with other affected areas and/or the NCMCs working group or the NACC

Realistic implementation dates should be set and implementation dates monitored, where appropriate.

> The management of the authority must be kept informed at all times to take action if necessary.

### NCMC WG 2023 TENTATIVE WORK PROGRAMME

The rapporteurs will coordinate 4 meetings during the year which will be held quarterly (may be modified as needed). Meetings will be virtual and coordinated with the Secretariat.

#### **First meeting (March 2023)**

#### Second meeting (June 2023)

- Classification of issues by critical element
- Creation of a task subgroup by technical area
- •Coordinate with the Secretariat and raise training needs to the directors.
- •Establish, together with the NACC Regional Office and RSOOs, technical support lines
- to solve difficulties in fulfilling the functions of the NCMCs • Preparation of the meeting report and coordination with the Secretariat



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
