




Global traffic: A recovery from the pandemic shock 4







NACC Passenger Traffic





- Passenger traffic in RPKs recovered by 71.2% in 2021 after the declined by -64.6% in 2020.
- Passenger traffic recovered higher than the world average.

- Seat Capacity in Available Seat-Kilometres (ASKs) recovered by 40.2% in 2021 after the decline by -50.4%.
- Capacity recovered higher than world average.


- Passenger load factor declined to 73.7% in 2021.
- Passenger load factor is higher the world average.

State ranking by Revenue Passenger-Kilometres


Airline ranking by Revenue Passenger-Kilometres



NACC Cargo Traffic




- **Cargo traffic measures in Freight Tonnes-Kilometres (FTKs) recovered** by 14.6% in 2021, surpassing the 2018-2019 results.
- FTK YOY rate is below the world

NACC Evolution of traffic



- Passenger traffic in NACC region in departure volume shows constant recovery since the pandemic shock in 2020.
- Scheduled passenger departure volume in 2022 recovered by 84% compared with 2019.
- Scheduled cargo departure volume, on the other hand, shows a slight decreasing phase after the pandemic.







ICAO Traffic and Economic dashboards

- Interactive dashboards developed using Tableau platform, which provide visualization and customized querying capabilities
- ★ cover a wide array of analytics ranging from operations, fleet usage, passenger carried, Flight Information Region (FIR) traffic, and revenue impact on airlines, airports and air navigation services providers (ANSPs) at different levels of granularity
- ★ Each Member States has been provided with a free license.

Development of Aviation Competitiveness Index 20


Objectives

- ★ The ACWG commonly agreed that the objective of the competitiveness index is to measure the performance of the aviation of a State and its ability to create and maintain value from the sector.
- use a standardized methodology to measure the level of competitiveness of the aviation sector.


- ★ 5 basic pillars of the index were determined: right chart




Outcome of the Eighth Joint Meeting of the Airport Economics Panel and the Air Navigation Services Economics Panel (AEP-ANSEP/8)

- New guidance and tools to support investment decisions of financing aviation infrastructure


