Interview with Pilots Operating at the Airport National Airlines

Items:

- 1. In the opinion of the pilot, what level of safety would you assign to the airport? On a scale of 0 to 10, what rating would you give to this airport?
- 2. If the airport receives a score lower than 10, ask what should be implemented by the airport to get closer to the maximum score;
- 3. Is the airport aeronautical information duly published on the web? (If not, what is not correct or what information should be added?)
- 4. Has the pilot ever identified a hotspot when he/she is in a taxiway through the airport? (If so, write the items on the airport letter)
- 5. Is there any spot in the airport maneuver area where the pilot would have difficulty defining his/her position (situational awareness)? (If so, write the spot/spots)
- 6. Does the pilot consider that the visual aids at this airport operate properly? (If not, what aid is missing or needs modification?)
- 7. Has there ever been a deviation or overshoot during landing or takeoff or a hazard? (If so, please provide details of the occurrence and whether the incident was reported)
- 8. Was there any hazard of a runway incursion during the taxiway approach? (If so, please mention the details of the occurrence)
- 9. Is communication with TWR always clear and comprehensible? (If not, list the items that could improve).
- 10. Ask the pilot if he/she would like to comment on airport runway safety.
