#### 2. Objectives

2.1 The objective of the workshop was to provide updates on the Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme (USOAP) Continuous Monitoring Approach (CMA), its latest development and evolution plan; to inform National Continuous Monitoring Coordinators (NCMCs) and other users on the latest tools, updates and functionalities developed to support the USOAP-CMA On-line Framework (OLF) and their applications; and to demonstrate how to conduct Protocol Questions (PQs) self-assessments and submit/update Corrective Action Plans (CAPs) on the OLF.

#### 3. Introduction

3.1 Under the sponsorship of the Monitoring, Analysis and Coordination (MAC) section of the Air Navigation Bureau (ANB) of ICAO, a USOAP-CMA Workshop was held at the ICAO North American, Central American and Caribbean (NACC) Regional Office in Mexico City, Mexico, from 11 to 13 December 2023, for the ICAO Member States from the NAM/CAR Regions. The Workshop was moderated by Mr. Marcelo Orellana, Regional Officer in Safety Implementation from the NACC Regional Office and delivered jointly by Mr. Junjian Nie, Chief of the Safety and Air Navigation Oversight Audit Section (OAS) and Mr. Hanna Jenno, Monitoring and Oversight Tools Analyst of the Oversight Support Unit (OSU) both from ICAO Headquarters ANB.

3.2 The Workshop was well received and highly appreciated by the participants. Feedback from delegates confirmed that the Workshop was informative, relevant and timely, which will greatly help the participants and their colleagues in better cooperating with the USOAP CMA to improve the fulfillment of their States' safety oversight obligations and enhance the safety of civil aviation of their States and the region.
