Safety Intelligence and Safety Performance Management Workshop Workshop Programme

Rationale: The proposed amendments to Annex 19 and the results of the ICAO Safety Management Implementation Challenges Survey of 2022 call for ICAO to provide support and guidance to States and various other stakeholders. As such, the ICAO Safety Management Section has updated and enhanced its suite of workshop related to safety intelligence and safety performance management.

Workshop Objectives: The workshop provides participants with knowledge and practical skills related to:

- understanding the importance and use of data for managing safety and making decisions;
 - developing a safety intelligence strategy; and
 - monitoring and managing safety performance.

Approach: The workshop consists of presentations, discussions, hands-on exercises, and case studies.

Target Audience: This workshop would be beneficial for administrators, experts and practitioners involved in planning, developing, and implementing:

- the State Safety Programme (SSP), including regulators and administrators of State regulatory bodies/Civil Aviation Authorities (CAAs), safety managers, safety specialists, etc.;
- Safety Management Systems (SMS), including safety managers and safety management practitioners of service providers;
- any aspect of safety intelligence or safety performance management.

Workshop Contents:

- 1. Overview of proposed amendments to Annex 19 (related to safety intelligence and safety performance management)
- 2. Data governance and management
- 3. Sharing and exchange of safety data and safety information
- 4. Development of indicators
- 5. Safety performance monitoring and management
